



# **Ribbon Baskets**

### **Materials:**

 Crochet hook size 5-8 (Refer to the gauge section for more information)

Hobbii Ribbon

#### **Measurements:**

Large: Base - Diameter 17 cm, height 9 cm.

Small: Base - Diameter 12 cm, height 7 cm.

Buy the yarn and supplies here:

Yarn usage: Approx.

Large: Grey 100g, Old rose 80g

Small: Grey 65g, Old rose 60g

# **Abbreviations:**

Mr: Magic ring

**St(s)**: Stitch(es)

**Sc**: Single crochet

**Lsc**: Long single crochet

Bl: Back loop

**Sl st**: slip stitch

**Gauge**: This pattern is written for a crochet hook 5 mm; however, the size is a guideline only and will depend on your own gauge. If the hook is too small, the base will bulge, and you will need to use a larger hook. Do a test to find out which hook will fit your own gauge and the Ribbon yarn.



## Pattern:

#### **Small:**

- 1. Begin with a mr and work 8 sc into the ring (8)
- 2. Work 2 sc in each st to the end of the round (16)
- 3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (24)
- 4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (32)
- 5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (40)
- 6. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (48)
- 7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 7 times in total. Work 1 sc in the last 6 sts (55)
- 8. This round is worked in the bl, without increases. Work 1 sc in the bl to the end of the round. (55)
- 9. Work 1 sc in each st to the end of the round. (55)
- 10. Work "1 lsc, 1 sc". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. (55)
- 11. Work "1 sc, 1 lsc". Repeat "to" to the end of the round, finish with 1 sc. (55)

  Repeat rounds 10 and 11 until you have a total of 8 rounds. Change color after round 3 if you wish.

Finish with 1 round of sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

#### Large:

- 1. Begin with a mr and work 8 sc into the ring (8)
- 2. Work 2 sc in each st to the end of the round (16)
- 3. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (24)
- 4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (32)
- 5. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (40)
- 6. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (48)
- 7. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (56)
- 8. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (64)
- 9. Work "1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 8 times in total. (72)
- 10. Work "1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" 7 times in total. Work 1 sc in the last 9 sts. (79)
- 11. This round is worked in the bl, without increases. Work 1 sc in the bl to the end of the round. (79)
- 12. Work 1 round of sc. (79)
- 13. Work "1 lsc, 1 sc". Repeat "to" to the end of the round. (79)
- 14. Work "1 sc, 1 lsc". Repeat "to" to the end of the round, finish with 1 sc. (79)

  Repeat rounds 13 and 14 until you have a total of 10 rounds. Change color after round 3 if you wish.

Finish with 1 round of sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



# **Photo tutorial:**

### 1st round:



1. We just finished working 1 sc in every sc, and now we work "1 lsc, 1 sc" as follows.



2. Work 1 lsc. This is a regular sc which is just longer. This means that it is worked into the sc of the previous round. The needle shows where to insert the hook for this lsc.



3. This is how it will look. You have now made 1 lsc.



4. Now, work 1 regular sc in the next stitch. The needle shows where to insert the hook.



5. Work 1 lsc. The needle shows where to insert the hook for this lsc.



6. This is how it will look.





**7.** Work 1 regular sc in the next stitch. Work "1lsc, 1 sc" to the end of the round.



8. Finish with 1 lsc. This was the first round.

## 2nd round:



9. Now, work a round of "1 sc, 1 lsc". Work 1 sc in the first stitch.



10. Then work 1 lsc. The lsc is to be worked around the regular sc of the previous round. The needle shows where to insert the hook for this lsc.



11. This is how it will look.



12. Now, work 1 regular sc in the next stitch.





13. Then 1 more lsc. Again, work in the sc of the previous round. The needle shows where to insert the hook for this lsc.



14. This is how it will look.



15. Work "1 sc, 1 lsc" to the end of the round.



16. Finish with 1 sc.



17. Repeat alternating these two rounds until you have reached the desired height of your basket. Change color after round 3 if you wish.



18. Finish with 1 round of sl st.







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
