



Ribbon Pc Sleeve

No. 1001-171-8199

Materials:

Crochet hook US size H/8 (5 mm). If you crochet tightly, then you can use a bigger hook.

Hobbii Ribbon

5.11 inches (13 cm) leather strap 0.98 inches (25 mm)

1 magnetic rivet

Possibly a hole punch tool

Buy yarn and supplies here:

Measurements: approx. 13" x 9.8" (33 x 25 cm).

Amount of yarn needed: approx. 14.1 oz. (400g).

Abbreviations:

ch: ch stitch

s: stitch

sc: single crochet

lsc: long single crochet

ss: slip stitch

Change the size:

If you wish to make the sleeve wider then you just add ch stitches until you have the desired width and continue in height, if you wish it higher/longer.

Pattern:

-Visual instructions available at the end of the pattern

-You crochet in a spiral so the rounds are not finished with a ss or started by chaining 1.

1. Start by chaining 35. In the 2. ch from the hook, work 2 sc. Work 1 sc in the next 32 chain stitches. In the last ch, work 4 sc. Now, continue on the other side of the foundation chain. Work 1 sc in the next 32 ch stitches. In the last s, work only 1 sc since you need to end up with an odd number of stitches. (71)
2. Work sc in each s around. (71)
3. Alternate between working "1 sc, 1 lsc" around. Finish with 1 sc. (71)
4. Alternate between "1lsc, 1sc" around. Finish with 1 lsc. (71)

Repeat rnd 3 and 4 until you have 33 rnds in total. Finish with 1 rnd of sc followed by 1 rnd of ss.



Cut a piece off the leather strap in a fitting length. Make 4 holes in one end and attach the leather strap onto the back side of the crocheted sleeve by sewing a cross as shown in the picture below.



Make 1 hole in the middle of the front of the leather strap, so the magnetic rivet can be attached.
 Attach the other part of the magnet rivet to the front, so it fits with the length of the leather strap. I have sewn back and forth over the rivet on the inside of the sleeve, so the rivet doesn't touch/scratch the PC.



Instruction:



1. Start by chaining a foundation chain.



2. In the 2. ch from the hook (here, marked by the needle).



3. Work 2 sc.



4. Work 1 sc in the next 32 sc.



5. In the last ch work 4 sc.



6. Now, work on the opposite side of the foundation ch. Work 1 sc in the next 32 ch. 1 sc in the last ch. (here, marked by the needle).



7. Work 1 sc. (71)



8. Work 1 rnd of sc. (71)

Pattern - Instructions:



1. Now, alternate between "1sc, 1lsc". 1 sc has just been crocheted.



2. Now, work 1 lsc. This is done in the s under the one you would normally work the next sc. The needle marks where you should work your sc, so it becomes a long sc.



3. Like this. Now, you have worked 1 sc, and 1 lsc.



4. The next sc is worked as you normally would in the next s.



5. Like this.



6. Now, work one more lsc. The needle shows where you should work your next s to make it a lsc.



7. Continue like this till the end of the round, and finish with 1 sc.



8. The next round is worked by alternating between "1lsc, 1 sc."



9. Here, the needle marks where your next s should be worked so it becomes a lsc.



10. Like this.



11. Next sc is worked as normally in the next s.



12. Continue like this in each round.
