



# Wattle stitch cloth

## Materials:

- Crochet hook no. C72-D/3 (3 mm)
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4.

Buy yarn and accessories here: http://shop.hobbii.com/wattle-stitch-cloth

**Measurements**: approx. 9½"x9½" (24x24 cm). If you want a larger cloth, just add any number of chain sts divisible by 3.

Usage: Approx. 1.8 oz. (50g) a piece.

#### **Abbreviations:**

Ch: Chain

St: Stitch

Sc: Single crochet

**Dc:** Double crochet



### Pattern:


- 1. Start with a foundation chain. Work 60 ch.
- 2. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, and 1 dc" in 3rd ch from the hook. Skip 2 sts and now work "1 sc, 1 ch and 1 dc in next st, skip 2 sts". Repeat across. Finish the row with 1 sc in last st.
- 3. Turn using 1 ch. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in all ch spaces from previous row. Finish the row with 1 sc in the turn st.

Repeat row no. 3 like this until you have the desired size of your cloth.

## <u>Guide:</u>



1. Start by casting on your foundation chain. The first sts are made in 3rd chain from the hook.



2. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in 3rd ch from the hook.






3. Skip 2 ch.

4. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in next ch.







6. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in next ch.







7. Repeat "skip 2 ch, work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in next ch across until you have 3 ch left.



9. Turn your work using 1 ch.





10. Now work in the ch spaces from the previous row.





11. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in 1st ch space.



13. Work "1 sc, 1 ch, 1 dc" in next ch space.



15. In the turn st work 1 sc. Now repeat this row until you have the desired size of your cloth.



12. Skip to next ch space.



14. Repeat across.
