



Knit Dishcloth- Corner to Corner

No. 2004-171-3331

Materials

- Knitting Needles US 2 ½ (3.0mm)
- Rainbow fra Hobbii

Buy the yarn here:

Gauge: 26 sts x 50 rows = 4" x 4"

Finished Size: 10" x 10"

Yarn Requirements:

50 g Rainbow, Color 12.

Abbreviations

st: stitch

k: knit

p: purl

YO: Yarn over (increase)

K f&b: knit into the front and back of the same stitch (increase)

SK2P: Slip 1, knit 2 together, pass the slipped stitch over.

Edge Stitch

With yarn in front, slip 1 stitch as if to purl. Move yarn to back and continue working in pattern. The last stitch of the row should be knit.

Pattern: -See the photo tutorial for additional information.

CO 2 sts.

Row 1: k f&b in the first st, k1 = 3 sts.

Row 2: k f&b in the first st, k1 = 4 sts..

From here on, increase with YOs to get the decorative edge with holes:

Row 3: 1 edge st, k1, YO, k2 = 5 sts.

Row 4: 1 edge st, k1, YO, k3 = 6 sts.

Continue like this until the edge with holes measures approx. 10".

This is the middle of the washcloth.

Now you will begin decreasing with the decorative holes on the edges:

Next row: 1 edge st, k1, YO, SK2P, Knit to the end of the row.

Repeat this row until there are 6 sts remaining.

Next row: Knit 2 sts together, knit to the end of the row = 5 sts.

Repeat this row until there are 3 sts remaining.

Next row: SK2P = 1 st.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



Photo Tutorial – Edge stitch:



1. Bring the yarn to the front of the work.



2. Slip 1 st as if to purl: Insert needle from right to left and slip the stitch to the right needle without knitting it.



3. Move the yarn to the back of the work.



4. The last stitch on the row should be knit. This technique gives the piece a finished look with a smooth edge on both sides.

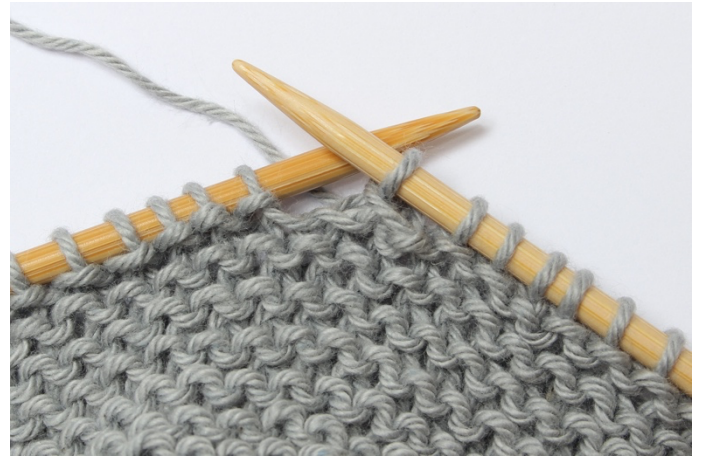
Photo Tutorial – SK2P:



1. Slip 1 st as if to purl: Insert needle from right to left and slip the stitch to the right needle without knitting it.



2. Knit 2 sts together: Insert the right needle through the next 2 sts from left to right and knit them as if they were 1 st.



3. Pass the slipped stitch over this new stitch.

4. The 3 sts are now decreased to 1.
