



Knitted Yarn Bag

Materials:

Double-pointed knitting needles US size 2.5 (3 mm). Rainbow Cotton 8/4 Stitch markers

Buy yarn and supplies here:

Knitting gauge:

21 stitches x 40 rounds = 4×4 inches (10×10 cm)

Measurements:

Base, diameter: 7.1 inches (18 cm) Circumference: 22.44 inches (57 cm)

Height: 7.5 inches (19 cm)

Amount of yarn needed

5.3 oz. **(**150 g) Hobbii Rainbow, Light jeans blue, color 28

Abbreviations:

s: stitch

r: row

rnd: round

K tblt: knit through back loop

1 s ktbl increase: Pick up the horizontal loop between the stitches and knit through the back loop.

Knitted cast-on: turn your work, insert the needle into the stitch as if to knit it, knit the stitch knitwise, knit the stitch through the back loop (from right to left) onto the left needle.

Garter stitch knitted in the round

Alternate between knitting 1 rnd knitwise and 1 rnd purlwise.



Pattern - Please view the visual guide at the end of the pattern:

Knit with double thread = 2 strands of yarn

Cast on with square

Start with a small square, like this: cast on 3 stitches and knit 6 rows knitwise.

Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 stitches up along the left side = 6 s.

Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 s up along the left side = 9 s.

Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 s up along the left side = 12 s.

Divide the stitches on 4 double-pointed needles. Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd.

Knit the base in the round in garter stitch, like this:

- **1. rnd (purl-rnd):** Work all stitches purlwise.
- **2. rnd (knit-rnd):** (k2, 1 increase) repeat until the end of the rnd = 6 increases = 18 stitches.
- **3. rnd every purl-rnd:** Work all stitches purlwise.
- **4. rnd (knit-rnd):** (k3, 1 increase) repeat until the end of the rnd = 6 increases = 24 stitches. Continue like this, with 1 stitch more between the increases on every knit-rnd until you have 19 stitches between the increases = 6×20 stitches = 120 stitches, and the base measures 7.1 inches (18 cm) in diameter. Place a marker at the start of the rnd.

The side of the bag:

Knit garter stitches straight up until the side measures 6.3 inches (16 cm) from the last rnd with the increases.

Handle:

- **1. rnd:** Knit 21 stitches, bind off 18 stitches, continue knitting until you have 39 stitches left on the rnd, bind off18 stitches, work the rest of the rnd.
- **2. rnd:** Continue knitting till you reach the bind off, cast on 18 stitches by using a knitted cast-on technique, continue knitting until you reach the other bind off, cast on 18 stitches by using the knitted cast-on technique, work the rest of the rnd.

Knit in the round in garter stitches until the handle measures 0.98 inches $(2\frac{1}{2}$ cm). Bind off and weave in the ends.









Instruction - 4-side cast on:




1. Cast on 3 stitches and knit 6 rnds knitwise.



2. Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 stitches = 6 stitches.



3. Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 stitches = 9 stitches.



4. Don't turn your work, but cast on 3 stitches = 12 stitches.



Instruction - knit 1 s through the back loop (increase):




1. Knit the horizontal loop between the stitches with the left needle.



2. Knit the loop through the back loop.



3. 1 increase (knit stitch through the back loop)



4. The knitted base with increases.



Instruction - knitted cast-on:



1. Turn the work, insert the needle knitwise into the stitch on the left needle.



2. Work the stitch knitwise, pull the stitch long and place this stitch twisted (from right to left) onto the left needle.



3. Repeat until every stitch is cast on.
