



Small Ribbon Pot

Materials:

- Crochet hook no. H/8 (5 mm)
- Hobbii Ribbon
- Leather strap 18mm 8.5 cm
- 1 rivet

Buy yarn and accessories here: http://shop.hobbii.com/small-ribbon-pot

Measurements: Bottom approx. 3" (7.5 cm) in diameter. Height approx. 3½" (8.5 cm)

Usage: Approx. 2½ oz. (70 g) a piece.

Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring

- Ch: Chain
- St: Stitch

Sc: Single crochet

Lsc: Long single crochet

Bl: Back loop

Sl st: Slip stitch

Alternating size: If you wan't a larger pot, continue increasing until you have the desired size of the bottom. After that, make the sides as high as you wan't them to be.

Note: 1 ch does NOT replace first stitch.

- 1. Make a Mr and work 6 sc into the ring. Finish with 1 sl st. (6)
- 2. Ch 1. Work 2 sc in all sts around. Finish with 1 sl st. (12)
- 3. Ch 1. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (18)
- 4. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (24)
- 5. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (30)
- **6.** Ch 1. This round is worked through bl without increases. Work 1 sc bl in all sts around. Finish with 1 sl st. (30)
- 7. Now work in a spiral. Work 1 round of sc. (30)
- **8.** This round is worked using lsc around. (30)

Now repeat rounds 7 and 8 all in all 6 times or until you reach the desired height of your basket/pot.

Finish your pot with 1 round of sl st. Finish and weave in ends.

Guide - Bottom:



1. Make a mr and work 6 sc into the ring. Finish with 1 sl st. (6)



2. Ch 1. Work 2 sc in all sts around. Finish with 1 sl st. (12)





3. Ch 1. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (18)



 Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (30)



7. This round is worked through bl without increases. Here the needle marks the back loop, where you should work your next sc.



4. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (24)



6. Ch 1.



8. This is how it looks now. Repeat around and finish with 1 sl st.





9. You've now made a fine edge from the bottom and up to where the sides are going to be made now.

Guide - Sides:



 Now work in a spiral. Work 1 round of sc. (30)



2. This round is worked using lsc around. A lsc is worked into the stitch below the stitch in which you would normally work. Here the needle marks where your lsc should be worked.





3. There. Now you've made your first lsc.



5. Work 1 round of sc as usual.



4. Repeat like this around using lsc.



6. Now work one round of lsc again. Here the needle marks where to work your next lsc.



7. Like this.



8. Repeat around.





9. Repeat the rounds alternately until you have all in all 6 rounds of lsc.

<u>Assembling – Leather strap:</u>



10. Finish with 1 round of sl st.



1. Cut your leather strap in the desired length and make a hole in each end.



2. Place the leather strap over the edge and attach with 1 rivet.



Place a little pot in it and you're good to go.
