



Large Ribbon Pot

Materials:

Crochet hook no. H/8 (5 mm)

- Hobbii Ribbon

Leather strap 25mm approx. 4½"
(11cm)

- 1 Rivet

Measurements: Bottom approx. 5½" (14 cm) in diameter. Height approx. 6.3" (16 cm).

Usage: Approx. 8.8 oz. (250g)

Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring

Ch: Chain

St: Stitch

Sc: Single Crochet

Lsc: Long Single Crochet

Bl: Back loop

Sl st: Slip stitch

Alternating the size: If you wish your pot to be larger, simply continue increasing until you have the desired size of your bottom. Then work the sides as tall as you wish them to be.

Note: 1 ch does NOT replace the first st.

- **1.** Make a mr and work 6 sc into the ring. Finish with 1 sl st. (6)
- **2.** Ch 1. Work 2 sc in all sts around. Finish with 1 sl st. (12)
- 3. Ch 1. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (18)
- 4. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (24)
- **5.** Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (30)
- 6. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (36)
- 7. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (42)
- **8.** Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (48)
- 9. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st. (54)
- **10.** Ch 1. This round is worked through bl without increases. Work 1 sc bl in all sts around. Finish with 1 sl st. (54)
- 11. Now work in a spiral. Work 1 round of sc. (54)
- 12.0n this round work lsc around. (54)

Now repeat rounds 11 and 12 all in all 13 times or until you reach the desired height of your basket/pot.

Finish your pot with 1 round of sl st. Finish and weave in ends.



Guide



1. Here the last round of the bottom has just been finished. (54)



2. Now work 1 round of sc through bl. Work 1 ch. Your next sc is worked through bl. The needle here marks where your next st should be made.



3. Like this.



4. The needle here marks where your next so should be made.



5. Like this.



6. Repeat around and finish with 1 sl st.





7. Now work in a spiral. So, don't start with 1 ch and don't finish with 1 sl st. Work 1 round of sc.



8. Now work one round of lsc. Lsc is worked like a normal sc, but in the st below the one in which you would normally work your next st. The needle here marks where your next sc should be made.



9. Like this. You've now made 1 lsc.



10. The needle here marks where your next lsc should be made.



11. Like this. You've now made another lsc.



12. Repeat around.





13. Work 1 round of sc as normally.



14. Again, work 1 round of lsc. The needle here marks where your next st should be made.



15. Repeat around.



16. Repeat the rounds alternately between sc and lsc until you have all in all 13 rounds of lsc or until you have the desired height of your pot.



17. Finish with 1 round of sl st.



Assembling - Leather strap:



1. Cut your leather strap to the desired length and make 1 hole in both ends.



2. Place the leather strap over the edge and assemble with 1 rivet.



Place a little pot in it and you're good to go.
