



Crocheted Rudolph

Materials:

- Crochet hook size 2,5 mm / US
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- Rainbow Cotton 8/4
- 2 safety eyes 8 mm
- 4 wooden beads 12 mm
- Soft toy filling
- Plastic granule

Usage:

- Brown ca. 20 g
- A little bit of dark red
- White ca. 3 g

Measurements: Approx. 10 cm without legs.

Abbreviations:

Mr: magic ring

Ch: chain stitch

St: stitch(es)

Sc: single crochet

Sc2tog: single crochet decrease (1 sc over 2 sc)

Sl st: slip stitch

Hdc: half double crochet

Dc: double crochet

Pattern

Legs and arms:

Ch 50 with brown and fasten off. This is for the legs.

Ch 49 with brown and fasten off. This is for the arms.

We will return to these two parts, as we begin with the assembly.



Body: use brown

1. Make a magic ring and work 6 sc in ring (6)
2. 2 sc in every sc on entire round (12)
3. "1 sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (18)
4. "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (24)
5. "1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (30)
6. Work this round through back loop of stitch: "1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (36)
7. "1 sc in each of the next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (42)
8. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
9. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
10. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
11. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
12. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
13. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
14. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)
15. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (42)

16. Now work: "1 sc in each of the next 5 sc, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (36)

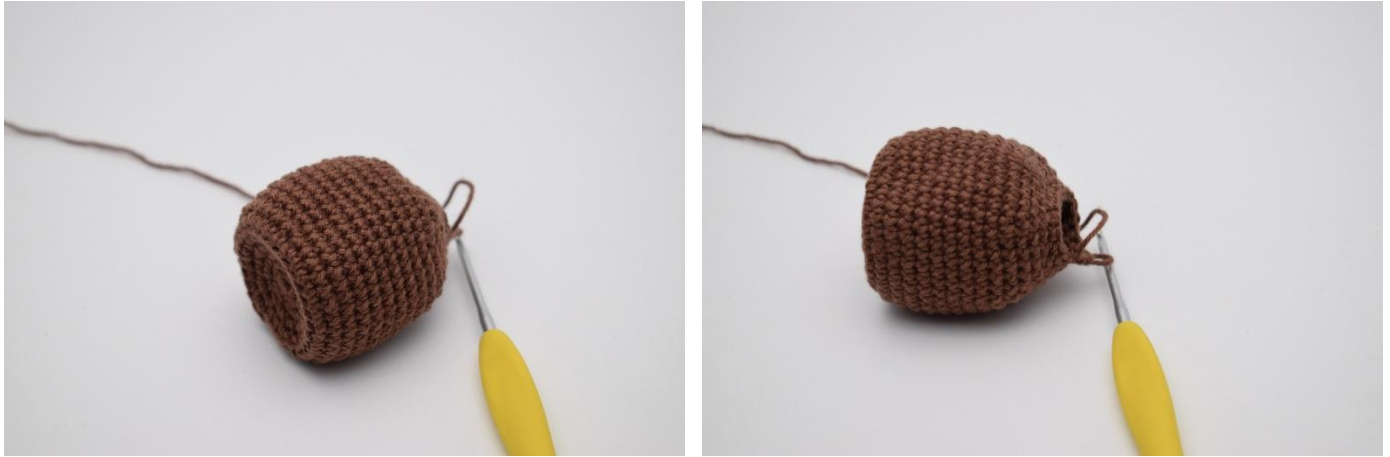
17. "1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, sc2tog" Repeat on entire round (30)

18. "1 sc in each of the next 3 sc, sc2tog" Repeat on entire round (24)

19. "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, sc2tog" Repeat on entire round (18)

20. "1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, sc2tog" Repeat on entire round (15)

Don't break the yarn, as we will continue from here.



Fill up the bottom of the body with plastic granule and stuff the rest of the body with the soft toy filling.

Head:

1. Work 2 sc in every sc on entire round (30)

2. Work: "1 sc in each of the next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (36)

3. "1 sc in each of the next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (42)

4. "1 sc in each of the next 6 m, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat on entire round (48)

5. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (48)

6. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (48)

7. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (48)

8. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (48)

9. Now work: "1 sc in each of the next 6 st, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (42)

10. "1sc in each of the next 5 st, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (36)

11. "1 sc in each of the next 4 m, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (30)

12. "1 sc in each of the next 3 m, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (24)

13. Work "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, sc2tog" Repeat on entire round (18). Now attach the safety eyes on to the head on row 6-7 and with 5-6 st in between the eyes. Begin stuffing the head, and make sure it's properly stuffed before closing completely.

14. Work "1 sc, sc2tog". Repeat on entire round (12)

15. Sc2tog on entire round (6)

Close the hole and fasten tightly.



Snout: use brown

1. Make a magic ring and work 6 sc in ring. (6)
2. Work "2 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 1 sc in next sc". Repeat from "to" a total of 2 times. (10)
3. "1 sc, 2 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 1 sc in next sc". Repeat from "to" a total of 2 times. (14)
4. "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in each of the next 3 sc". Repeat from "to" a total of 2 times. (18)
5. "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc". Repeat from "to" a total of 6 times. (24)
6. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (24)
7. 1 sc in every sc on entire round (24)
8. Work "1 sc in each of the next 2 sc, sc2tog". Repeat from "to" a total of 6 times. (18)

Cut the yarn but leave long end for assembly. Sew the snout on to the head, don't forget to stuff it before it's completely attached.



Nose: use red

1. Make a magic ring and work 5 sc in ring. (5)
2. 2 sc in every sc on entire round. (10)

Cut the yarn but leave long end for assembly. Sew the nose on to the snout.



Ear: use brown – make 2 pcs.

1. Ch 5.
2. Work 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch and 1 dc in last ch.

Cut the yarn but leave long end for assembly. Sew the ears on to the head.



Antler:

Go find two little twigs / branches and cut into shape. Attach the antlers to the head in between the ears.



Now attach the legs. Use a needle and pull the needle and leg-chain through row 6 on the downside of the body. Pull the leg-ch out on the other side with 6-7 st in between the legs. Attach the beads on each leg and tie a knot on the end.



Now pull the arm-chain through the body, just 2 rounds under the head. Use the needle and pull needle and chain through one side of the body and out on the other side. Attach the beads and tie a knot.



Scarf: use white

1. Ch 45
2. Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and work 1 sc in every ch on entire row. (44)
3. Ch 1 to turn and work 1 sc in every sc on row. (44)

Fasten off and dress up Rudolph with his scarf 😊
