



Crochet Makeup Bag

No. 1001-171-3999

Materials:

- Crochet hook size 4 mm / US G/6
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4. Work with 2 strands.
- Zipper 25 cm.
- 20 cm. (7,9") leather string (optionally)

Measurements: 23 x 14 cm (9x5,5 inches)

Usage: approx. 90 g

Abbreviations:

Ch: chain stitch

St: stitch

Sc: single crochet

Lsc: long single crochet

Sl st: slip stitch

Pattern: You can also find a tutorial with pictures below.

Work with 2 strands.

1. Ch 39 with crochet hook size 4 mm / US G/6.
2. Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Work 1 sc in each of the next 36 ch and work 4 sc in the last ch. Now you continue working on the other side of the ch-row. Work 1 sc in each of the next 36 ch. Work 1 sc in last ch, as we need an uneven number of stitches. (79)
3. Work 1 sc in each st on entire round. (79)
4. Work "1 sc, 1 lsc", repeat from " to " on entire round. (79)
5. Now work "1 lsc, 1 sc" and repeat from " to " on entire round. (79)

Now repeat rounds 4-5 a total of 15 times, meaning you have worked a total of 30 rounds in pattern, or continue until your bag has a desired height. Finish with working one round sc's and one round sl sts. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Sew the zipper in the bag. You can attach a leather string in the zipper if wanted. You can find a video tutorial on how to sew the zipper in the bag here: <https://youtu.be/3B48roTugYs>



Instruction:

Row 1:



1. Begin by working your chain row. In 2nd ch from hook (The needle on the photo shows the second ch)



2. You work 2 sc.



3. Work 1 sc in each of the next 36 ch (The needle shows the last ch)



4. Work 4 sc in the last ch. Now work on the other side of your ch-row.



5. Work 1 sc in the next 36 ch.



6. In the last ch (The needle shows the last ch)



7. You work 1 sc. (79) Work 1 round sc's before beginning on the pattern.

Pattern instruction:



1. Work one sc in the first st and now you will work 1 lsc in the next st. A lsc looks exactly like a normal sc, only you work the st from the previous round. The needle on the photo shows where to work your lsc.



2. A lsc looks like this.



3. Work 1 normal sc in the next st.



4. Like this.



5. Work a lsc again in the next st. You work this like a normal sc, but in the st from the previous round. (The needle shows where to work your lsc)



6. Like this.



7. Work a normal 1 sc in the next st.



8. Repeat these sts alternately on entire round.



9. In the next round you work the stitches the other way around. This means you begin with 1 lsc, followed by 1 sc. Meaning you work 1 lsc in sc from previous round and 1 sc in lsc from previous round. Repeat the 2 rounds until the bag has a desired height.

Finish:



Finish with a round of sc's and here after a round of sl sts.



Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Sew the zipper in the bag.



You can attach a leather string to the if wanted.
