## Crocheted Christmas Tree Skirt

## Materials:

Crochet Hook US size K/10.5-L/11 (7 mm)
(If your tension is tight, you can go up a hook size)
Hobbii Ribbon
Buy yarn and accessories here:

Measurements: Approx. 47.2 inches (approx. 120 cm ) in diameter

## Usage:

Red approx. 5 skeins
Nature approx. 2 skeins
Change size:
If you want the skirt in a different size, you can just make more or less rounds

## Pattern: See the illustrated instructions further down in the pattern.

1. Start in red and make a mr. Make 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ). Work " 2 dc and 1 ch " in the ring. Repeat "to" another 4 times. Work 1 dc in the ring and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 12 dc ).
2. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 2 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 2 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 24 dc ).
3. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 4 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 4 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round (36 dc).
4. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 6 st. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 6 st ". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round (48 dc).
5. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 8 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 8 st ". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 60 dc ).
6. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 10 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 10 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round (72 dc).
7. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 12 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 12 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 84 dc ).
8. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 14 st. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 14 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 96 dc ). Cut the yarn.
9. Now switch to nature. Start in a ch gap with the new color. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 16 st. "In the next ch gap work 1 dc , $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 16 st ". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 108 dc ).
10. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 18 st . "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 18 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round (120 dc). Cut the yarn.
11. Now switch to red. Start in a ch gap with the new color. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 20 st. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, 1 dc . Work 1 dc in the next 20 st ". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 132 dc ).
12. Make 1 sl st to the first ch gap. Here you work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ), work 1 dc into the ch gap. Work 1 dc in the next 22 st. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 22 st". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round (132 dc). Cut the yarn.

Now continue your rounds as descibed above with alternately 2 rounds of nature and 2 rounds of red until you have 28 rounds all in all (each round is increased with 12 st). Work 2 more rows of red so you have 4 rounds of red. Don't finish.

Now work 1 round of sc. Work " $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ " in all ch gaps and 1 sc in all other sts around. Finish and weave in the ends.

## 2. round



1. Work 1 sl st to the ch gap. Work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ).

2. Work 1 dc in the next 2 sts.

3. Work 1 dc in the next 2 sts.

4. Work 1 dc into the same ch gap.

5. In the next ch gap work " $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ ".

6. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 2 sts". Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round ( 24 dc ).

## 3. round



1. Work 1 sl st to the ch gap. Work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ). Work 1 dc into the ch gap.

2. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 4 st ".

3. Work 1 dc in the next 4 st.

4. Repeat "to" around and finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch from the beginning of the round (36 dc).

## 4. round



1. Work 1 sl st to the ch gap. Work 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch ). Work 1 dc into the ch gap.

2. "In the next ch gap work $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$. Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts".

3. Work 1 dc in the next 6 sts.

4. Repeat "to" around and finsh with 1 sl st in 3 rd ch from the beginning of the round (48 dc).

The rounds are repeated like this and increased with 12 dc each round.

Color switch: When you switch color, do like this:


1. In a random ch gap you start with the new color by working 4 ch (replaces 1 dc and 1 ch) and work 1 dc in the same ch gap.

## The border:


29. Finish with 1 round of sc in the same color as the previous round. Work 1 sc, 1 ch, 1 sc into the ch gap and 1 sc in all other sts. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

2. Work on as normally.
