



Ribbon Easter Basket with leather handle

Materials:

- Crochet hook H- L (as needed for correct gauge)
- Hobbii Ribbon
- 2 rivets
- 14 ½” leather strap- 1” wide
- Leather punch

Finished Size: Approx. 7” in diameter, 4” tall

Yarn Requirement: Approx. 200g (1 skein)

Abbreviations:

- st:** stitch
sc: single crochet
long-sc: long single crochet
BL: back loop
Sl st: slip stitch

Gauge: This can be worked with a H hook (5.0mm) but the size is dependent on how tightly or loosely you crochet.

If the hook is too small the base will begin to curve into a bowl. If this happens, try a larger hook.

Pattern:

1. Starting with a magic ring, work 6 sc into the ring. End with a sl st. (6)
2. Ch 1. Work 2 sc in each st. End with a sl st. (12)
3. Ch 1. Work "1 sc, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (18)
4. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (24)
5. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (30)
6. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (36)
7. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (42)
8. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (48)
9. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (54)
10. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2 sc in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (60)
11. Ch 1. Work 1 sc into the BL of each st to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (60)
12. Now you will begin working in a spiral. Work 1 rnd of sc. (60)
13. Work 1 rnd of long-sc in each st. (work into the base of the row below) (60)

Repeat rows 12 and 13 a total of 7 times. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Cut the leather strap so you have a piece that is approx. 14 ½", rounding the corners slightly. Using the leather punch, make a hole on either end. Attach the handle to the basket with the rivets.



Photo Tutorial:



1. This is what the base should look like at the end of round 10.



2. Ch 1, Work 1 sc into the BL of each st to the end of the rnd. The needle is indicating where to insert the hook.



3. End with a sl st.



4. Now you will begin working in a spiral. Work 1 rnd of sc



5. Work 1 rnd of long-sc in each st. Long-sc is worked into the row below where you would normally work. The needle is indicating where to insert the hook.



6. The 1st long-sc worked.



7. The next long-sc is worked in the same way. The needle indicates where to insert the hook in the row below where you would normally work.



8. Like this. There are now 2 long-sc.



9. Repeat long-sc in each st to the end of the rnd.



10. On the next rnd work regular sc.



11. Now repeat the rnd with long-sc. The needle indicates where to work the first st.



12. Like this.



13. The next long-sc is worked in the same way. The needle indicates where to insert the hook in the row below where you would normally work.



14. Like this.



15. Repeat long-sc in each st to the end of the rnd.



16. Repeat these 2 rnds as instructed in the pattern. End with a sl st.



Cut the leather strap so you have a piece that is approx. 14 ½", rounding the corners slightly. Using the leather punch, make a hole on either end.



17. Attach the handle to the basket with the rivets.
