Happy Bow Hat

Size: Baby (junior) adult
Yarn: 1 skein of Happy Sheep Woolpower
Needle: 16" Circular needle US 8 (5 mm)
Gauge: 17 sts = 4"

The hat is knit from the bottom up. The last stitches are divided in 2 and the leaves are worked from these.

Hat

CO 60, (68), 80 sts. Join to knit in the round.

Work in rib pattern *k2, p2* until the piece measures 1 (1 ½) 1 ½ in.

For the junior size increase evenly by 2 sts on the last rnd = 60 (70) 80 sts.

Continue working in stockinette (knit all sts) until the piece measures 5 (6) 6 ¼ in.

Decreasing

Rnd 1: k 5 (5) 5 sts, *slip 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over the knit st, knit 8 (10) 12 Repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Rnd 2: knit all sts.

Continue in this pattern, decreasing by 1 st between decreases until there are 10 (10) 10 sts remaining. End with rnd 2.

Leaves

The leaves are knit the same for all sizes.

Divide the remaining 10 sts on 2 needles. Work flat.

Work 5 rows in stockinette. Slip the first st on each row. End with a row of purl sts.

Right Side:

Slip the first st, k1, YO, k1, YO, k2 = 7 sts.

Wrong Side:

Slip the first st, purl to the end of the row.

Increase evenly from the middle point until there are 15 sts on the needle, end with a row of purl sts.

Decreasing

Row 1: Slip the first st, k2tog tbl, k9, k2tog, k1 = 13 sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Slip the first st, k2tog tbl, k7, k2tog, k1 = 11 sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Continue in this pattern until there are 3 sts remaining.

Next row (RS): Slip 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass the slipped sts over this st = 1 st.

Cut the yarn and pull through to end. Weave in the ends.

Knit the second leaf to match the first.

Tie a knot with the 2 leaves.

Enjoy your new hat!
