Vera's Sweater

- Size:** 3-4 years (5-6 years) 7-8 years
- Usage:** Yarn: 3, (3), 4 balls Hobbii Baby Merino col. 47,
And 2, (3), 3 balls Hobbii Kid Silk col. 08.
- Needles:** Circular needles 60 cm size 4 mm / US size 6 and 4,5 mm / US size 7.
And double pointed needles size 4 mm / US size 6 and 4,5 mm / US size 7.
- Gauge:** 20 stitches = 10 cm

The sweater is worked bottom up. The sleeves and body are connected on one needle and you finish by working the yoke.

Abbreviations

CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
st(s) = stitch(es)
inc = increase

k2tog = knit 2 sts together
yo = yarn over
dec = decrease
tbl = through back loop

Body

CO 132 (140) 148 st on circular needles 4 mm / US 6 size and work rib *k 1, p 1* in the round. Repeat *-* until piece measures 3 cm.

Knit one round and switch to circular needles 4,5 mm / US size 7.

Begin working the pattern.

PLEASE READ THE REST OF THE PATTERN THOROUGHLY BEFORE CONTINUING WORKING THE PATTERN!

Insert one marker at the beginning of the round and a second marker after 66 (70) 74 stitches (= front piece). The pattern is worked over the first half of the body over 62 (68) 68 stitches. Work the first round as follows: k 2 (1) 3 *k2tog, yo, k 4*. Repeat from * to * 10 (11) 11 times, finish with k2tog, yo, and k 2 (1) 3. Work the rest of the stitches (= back piece) in stockinette st.

Knit 3 rounds. In the 5th round you displace the pattern, meaning you now work as follows: k 5 (4) 6, *k2tog, yo, k 4*. Repeat from * to * 9 (10) 10 times, finish with k2tog, yo, and k 5 (4) 6. Work the rest of the stitches (= back piece) in stockinette st. Knit 3 rounds.

Repeat these 8 rounds until piece measures 28 (31) 34 cm. In the last round, bind off 8 sts for armholes on each side of the body (= 4 sts on each side of both markers).□

You will slip the sleeves on to the same circular needles as the body where you bound off these 8 sts.

Sleeves

CO 40 (44) 48 masker on double pointed needles 4 mm / US size 6 and work rib *k1, p1* in the round. Repeat *-* until piece measures 3 cm.

Insert one marker at the beginning of the round. Knit one round and switch to double pointed needles 4,5 mm / US size 7. Continue in stockinette stitch.

When piece measures 5 cm you inc 1 st on each side of marker as follows: yo, k 1, yo. On the next round k the yo tbl to avoid holes. Repeat inc every 5 cm, a total of 5 (6) 6 times = 50 (56) 60 sts on needle.

Work until piece measures 27cm (30cm) 33cm.

On your last round, bind off 8 sts for the armhole (= 4 sts on each side of marker). This armhole will be placed over the bound off sts on the body.

Put piece aside and work one more sleeve the same way.

Yoke

Slip the sleeves on to the same circular needle as body where armholes were bound off.

Insert one marker in every transition; between front piece and sleeve, sleeve and back piece, back piece and sleeve and sleeve and front piece = 4 markers.

Knit 1 round to “attach” the sleeves.

Raglan decreases

Now work the raglan dec as follows: *work until 2 sts before marker, k2tog, (marker), k2tog tbl *. Repeat from * to * by every marker on the round = 8 sts dec.

Knit 1 round.

Repeat this dec by every marker in every 2nd round and continue working the pattern as described on front piece.

Dec until you have 88 (92) 92 sts on needle.

Switch to double pointed needles 4 mm / US size 6 and knit 1 round and hereafter 3 cm rib *k 1, p 1*.

Loosely bind off all sts.

Weave in yarn.
