



Ribbon Bag

Materials:

Crochet hook size H/8 (5.00 mm) (If you tend to crochet tightly, it can be an advantage to use hook size J/10 (6.00 mm) instead)

Hobbii Ribbon

Leather handle

Magnetic button with flap – 1 in (4 cm)

12 rivets, 9 x 13 mm

Supplies: Approx. 550g Ribbon

Measurement: Approx. 16 in wide and 11.5 in tall. (Measured when the bag is laying down flat)

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

St: Stitch

Sl st: Slip stitch

Sc: Single crochet

Blo: Back loop only

Dc: Double crochet

Fptc: Front post triple crochet

K st: Knit stitch

Bottom:

1. Ch 24.
2. Sc 1 in the 3rd ch from the hook and then sc 1 in the next 20 ch. Sc 5 in the last ch. Now crochet into the other side of the chain. Sc 1 in the next 21 ch. Sc 5 in the last ch and finish with a sl st. (52)



3. Ch 1 and sc 1 into the same st. Sc 1 in the next 20 st (total of 21 st). Now sc 2 in each of the next 5 st. Sc 1 in the next 20 st. Sc 2 in each of the next 5 st. Finish with a sl st. (62)



4. Ch 1 and sc 1 into the same st. Sc 1 in the next 20 st (total of 21 st). Now "sc 1 in next st, sc 2 in the following st". Repeat from " to " a total of 5 times. Sc 1 in the next 21 st. Now "sc 1 in next st, sc 2 in the following st". Repeat from " to " a total of 5 times. Finish with a sl st. (72)



5. Ch 1 and sc 1 into the same st. Sc 1 in the next 20 st (total of 21 st). Now “sc 1 in next 2 st, sc 2 in the following st”. Repeat from “ to “ a total of 5 times. Sc 1 in the next 21 st. Now “sc 1 in next 2 st, sc 2 in the following st”. Repeat from “ to “ a total of 5 times. Finish with a sl st. (82)



6. Ch 1 and sc 1 into the same st. Sc 1 in the next 20 st (total of 21 st). Now “sc 1 in next 3 st, sc 2 in the following st”. Repeat from “ to “ a total of 5 times. Sc 1 in the next 21 st. Now “sc 1 in next 3 st, sc 2 in the following st”. Repeat from “ to “ a total of 5 times. Finish with a sl st.(92) The bottom now measures approx. 11.5 inches.



7. Ch 1. Now you'll sc in blo all round, finish with a sl st. (92)



1. Now you'll sc one round in back loop only. Ch 1. Sc all way round, into the loop marked here by the needle. Finish with a sl st.



2. Your work will look like this.

Guide - Bottom - Finishing a round:



1. When you finish your round with a sl st, it can look like you're skipping a stitch. However, this stitch is called a fake stitch and you do not crochet into it.



2. Sl st into the st marked here by the needle.



3. Your joint will look like this.

Sides- See further down the pattern for the picture guide.

1. Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc). Dc 1 in each st all round. Finish with a sl st into the 3rd ch. (92)
2. Ch 1 (replaces 1 sc). Sc 1 into each st all round and finish with a sl st into 1st ch. (92)
3. Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc). Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. "Dc 1 in next st, fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round". Repeat from " to " the remainder of the round. Finish with a sl st into 3rd ch.

4. Ch 1 (replaces 1 sc). Sc 1 into each st all round and finish with a sl st into 1st ch. (92)
5. Ch 1 and fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. "Dc 1 in next st, fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round". Repeat from " to " the remainder of the round. Finish with a sl st into 1st fptc.

Repeat rounds 2-5 until your bag reaches the desired height. The model shown was made crocheting 5 repeats.

Guide - Sides:



1. Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc).



2. Dc 1 in each st all round. Finish with a sl st.



3. Ch 1. Sc 1 into each st all round and finish with a sl st.



4. Ch 3 (replaces 1 dc).



5. Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. The needle here shows how to crochet around the dc from the front.



6. Your work now looks like this.



7. Dc 1 in next st.



8. Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. The needle here shows how to crochet around the dc from the front.



9. Like this.



10. "Dc 1 in next st, fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round". Repeat from " to " the remainder of the round. Finish with a sl st.



11. Dc 1 in each st all round. Finish with a sl st.



12. Ch 1. Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. The needle here shows how to crochet around the dc from the front.



13. Like this



14. Dc1 in next st.



15. Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round. The needle here shows how to crochet around the dc from the front.



16. Like this.



17. Dc 1 in next st.



18. "Fptc 1 around the next dc under the previous round, dc 1 in next st". Repeat from " to " the remainder of the round. Finish with a sl st. Repeat these rounds as described in the pattern.

Rim: See further down in the pattern for a picture guide.

1. Ch 1. Sc 1 in same st, sc 1 in each st all round and finish with a sl st. (92)
2. Ch 1. K st all round and finish with a sl st.

Repeat round 2 a total of 3 times.

Now sl st one round. Cut the yarn and weave in the end.

Guide - Rim:



1. Ch 1 (replaces 1 sc). Sc 1 in same st, sc 1 in each st all round and finish with a sl st. (92)



2. Now for the knit stitches. Ch 1. K st 1 into the v of the st below. The needle here shows you where to put your sc.



3. We've now made the first knit stitch.



4. Crochet next sc into the following "v". The needle here shows you where to put your sc.



5. We've now crocheted another knit stitch.



6. Now K st all round and finish with a sl st.



7. Repeat the round until you have a total of 3 k st rounds.



8. Now sl st one round.

Cut the yarn and weave in the end. Your bag is now ready to have the handles attached.

Adding the magnetic button:

Sew one flap on either side of the inside of the bag as shown in the picture below. Sy 1 flap på hver side inden i tasken som på billedet herunder. You can use sewing thread, yarn or embroidery thread. Now the bag can be closed at the middle.





Adding the handles:

You can use any handle you like. They are available in short or long, with or without hook and in many different colours. You can see a large assortment of handles and other accessories here:

On this bag we used a fabulous 31 inch (80 cm) leather handle which is easily added using studs either side.



If you choose to use a different handle, like one with a hook and a d-ring, you would add it using ribbon yarn to sew the rings on at the desired distance from each other. Then you can clip on the handle with the “lobster claw” clip.
