



Storage bag with leather bottom square – big

No. 1001-171-5265

Materials:

- Crochet hook 5 mm (US size H/8).
If you usually crochet quite tight,
then choose a larger hook size.
- Hobbii Ribbon
- Go Handmade leather bottom 18
x18 cm
- 2 12 cm black leather straps 18 mm
- 4 rivets 6 x 9 mm
- Leather hole punch (optional)

Usage: Approx. 250 g. Hobbii Ribbon

Measurements: 22 x 22 x 13 cm. (LxWxH)

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain stitch

St: Stitch

Sl st: Slip stitch

Sc: Single crochet

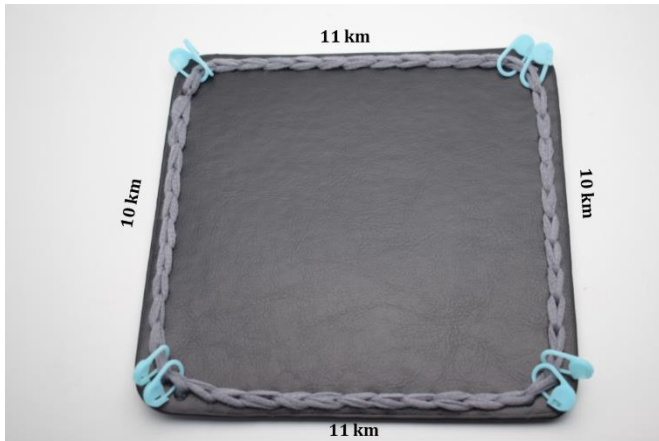
BLO: Back loop only

Lsc: Long single crochet (aka spike stitch)

Pattern:

- You can also follow the picture guide below.

Begin by working sl st in the holes on the leather bottom. Make sure the sl st are worked loose and lies neatly along the bottom edge. If the bottom begins to bend, try to work a bit looser or change to a larger size crochet hook. Cut the yarn, pull the yarn end through the hole and tie a knot.



Place a marker in each of the 2 sl st in every corner. You now have 10 sl st along 2 of the edges and 11 sl st along the 2 other edges besides the ones in each corner.

Place your bottom in front of you as shown on the photo, the edges with 10 sl st are in a vertical position ("km" = sl st).

Work sc's in the sl st on the bottom as follows:

1. Begin in the top left corner after the 2 corner markers. Work "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st". Repeat from "to" 5 times. Work 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.
Now work along the bottom horizontal edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st" Repeat from "to" 5 times. 1 sc in next sl st and 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.
Now work along the right vertical edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st". Repeat from "to" 5 times. Work 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.
Now work along the top vertical edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st" Repeat from "to" 5 times. 2 sc in next sl st and 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st. Finish with 1 sl st. (87)
 2. Ch 1, 1 sc in every sc on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (87)
 3. Ch 1, 1 sc BLO in every sc on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (87)
 4. Now work a spiral pattern. This means, you do **not** begin each round with ch 1 or finish each round with 1 sl st. Work "1 sc, 1 lsc". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sc. (87)
 5. "1 lsc, 1 sc". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 lsc. (87)
- Repeat round 4 and 5 a total of 8 times and finish the last round with 1 sl st.

Top edge:

1. Ch 1, 1 sc in every st on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st.
 2. Ch 1, 1 lsc in every sc on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st
- 1 sl st in every lsc on entire round. Cut the yarn and weave in ends

Instruction – bottom:



1. Work slip stitches in the holes on the leather bottom. Begin in top left corner as shown on the photo above.



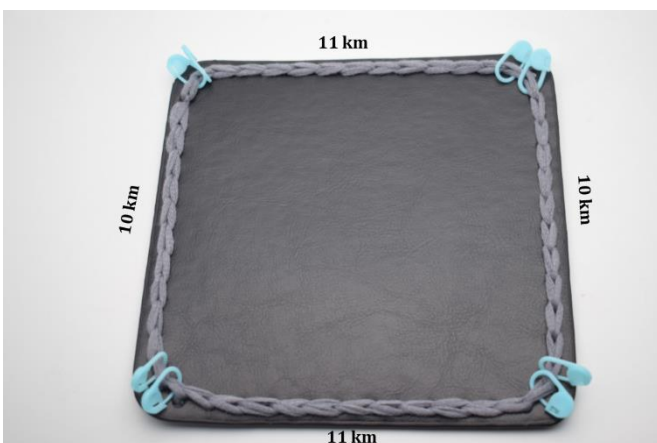
3. Work slip stitches in the holes all the way round.



1. Cut the yarn.



4. Pull the yarn end through the hole and tie a knot on the backside of the bottom. Weave in the yarn ends around the stitches on the backside.



Place a marker in each of the 2 sl st in every corner. There are now 10 sl st along 2 of the edges and 11 sl st along the 2 other edges besides the ones in each corner.

Place your leather bottom in front of you as shown on the photo. The edges with 10 sl st are in a vertical position (“km” = sl st).

Round 1



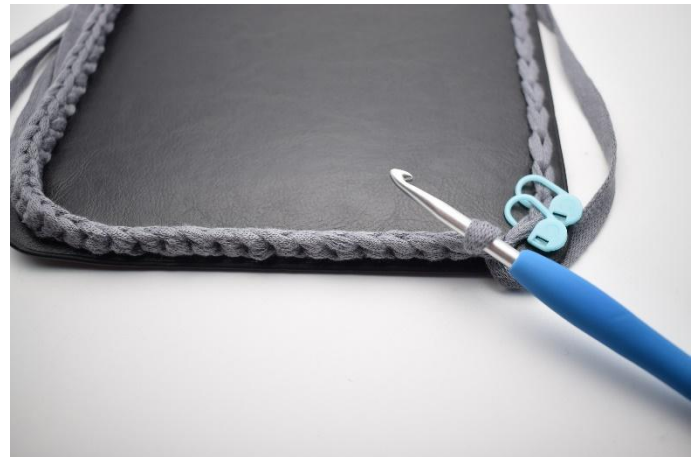
1. Attach yarn in top sl st in the left corner.



2. Work "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st". Repeat from "to" 5 times.



3. Work 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.



4. Work along the bottom horizontal edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st" Repeat from "to" 5 times. 1 sc in next sl st.



5. 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.



6. Work along the right vertical edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st". Repeat from "to" 5 times.



7. 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.



8. Work along top horizontal edge: "1 sc in first sl st, 2 sc in next sl st" Repeat from "to" 5 times. 2 sc in next sl st.



9. 3 sc in each of the 2 corner sl st.



10. Finish with 1 sl st.

Round 2



1. Ch 1, 1 sc in every sc on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st.

Round 3



1. Ch 1. In this round you work sc BLO. The needle shows the back loop, where you work your sc.



2. Like this. Repeat in every sc on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st.



3. You have now worked one round sc BLO.



Instruction -sides:

Round 1



1. Now work the spiral pattern. This means that you do **not** begin each round with ch 1 or finish with 1 sl st. Work 1 sc in first sc.



2. Work 1 lsc in next st. The needle shows where to work your lsc.



3. Like this. You have now worked 1 sc and 1 lsc.



4. Work 1 sc in next st.



5. 1 lsc in next sc. The needle shows where to work your lsc.



6. Like this. Repeat "1 sc, 1 lsc" on entire round.



7. Finish with 1 sc.

Round 2



1. Work 1 lsc. The needle shows where to work your lsc.



2. Like this.



3. Work 1 sc in next st. You have now worked 1 lsc and 1 sc.



4. Work 1 lsc in next st. The needle shows where to work your lsc.



5. Like this.



6. Work 1 sc in next st.



7. Repeat on entire round and finish with 1 lsc.



8. Repeat these 2 round a total of 8 times or until your basket has the height you want.

Instruction - Top edge:



1. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in every st on entire round and finish with 1 sl st.



2. Ch 1. Work 1 lsc in every sc on entire round. The needle shows where to work your first lsc.



3. Like this.



4. The needle shows where to work your next lsc.



5. Like this.



6. Repeat on entire round and finish with 1 sl st.



7. Finish with 1 round of sl st.

Attaching leather strap:



Cut your leather strap, so it measures approx. 12 cm (3,15 in). Punch through the holes in each end of the strap using a leather hole punch



1. Attach the strap to the basket with the rivets and use a hammer to assemble.



2. Make sure that the strap is attached like this (slightly bended), so you can use it as handle.
