



Trivet with flower motif

No. 1001-171-5806

Materials:

- Crochet Hook L (8mm)
- Hobbii Snowstorm

Buy the yarn and materials here: http://shop.hobbii.com/trivet-flower-motif

Measurements: Approx. 7-8 inches – *See the section about felting below.*

Yarn Requirements: Approx. 60g.

Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

St: stitch

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

dc: double crochet

BuSt: bubble stitch

Note: The trivet cannot withstand extremely high temperatures, but it is perfect for warm bowls, plates or teapots.



Pattern: -photo tutorial can be found after the written pattern.

All bubble stitches are made on the wrong side. You can push the bubble out to the right side so they are all on the front when the piece is finished.

- 1. Make a magic ring. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc) work 11 dc in the ring and end with a sl st. (12)
- 2. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 2 dc in each of the following sts to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (24)
- 3. Ch 1. Work " 2 sc in the first st, 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st, 1 BuSt in the next st" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (36) There are 6 BuSt on this rnd.
- 4. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 3 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (45)
- 5. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts. Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 4 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (54)
- 6. Ch 1. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 1 BuSt in the next st" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (54) There are 18 BuSt on this rnd.
- 7. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 2 sts. Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (72)

Cut yarn and weave in ends. Wash the trivet in a machine on a hot cycle to felt. If it is not felted enough after the first wash, run it work one more cycle. Shape while wet by pushing all of the bubble stitches into shape as needed.

Bubble Stitch: - See photo tutorial for rnd 3.

Work the BuSt as follows:

Wrap yarn over the hook and insert into st. Wrap yarn over the hook again and pull through the st. You now have 3 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through 2 of the loops. There are now 2 loops remaining on the hook.

Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert into the same st again, wrap yarn and pull through st. You now have 4 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through the first 2 loops. There are 3 loops remaining on the hook.

Repeat a total of 5 times, until you have 6 loops remaining on the hook.

Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull through all 6 loops. Pull to tighten a little. Your BuSt is now on the back side of the work, push it through to the front side with your finger.



Photo Tutorial:

Rnd 1:



 Make a magic ring. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc) work 11 dc in the ring and end with a sl st. (12) **Rnd 2:**



1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 2 dc in each of the following sts to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (24)

Rnd 3:



1. Ch 1.



2. Work " 2 sc in the first st, 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st.

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3. Now you will work 1 BuSt: Wrap yarn over the hook and insert into st. Wrap yarn over the hook again and pull through the st. You now have 3 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through 2 of the loops. There are now 2 loops remaining on the hook.



4. Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert into the same st again, wrap yarn and pull through st. You now have 4 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through the first 2 loops. There are 3 loops remaining on the hook.



5. Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert into the same st again, wrap yarn and pull through st. You now have 5 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through the first 2 loops. There are 4 loops remaining on the hook.



6. Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert into the same st again, wrap yarn and pull through st. You now have 6 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through the first 2 loops. There are 5 loops remaining on the hook.

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7. Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert into the same st again, wrap yarn and pull through st. You now have 7 loops on the hook. Wrap yarn and pull through the first 2 loops. There are 6 loops remaining on the hook.



 Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull through all 6 loops. Pull to tighten a little. Your BuSt is now on the back side of the work.



9. Work " 2 sc in the first st, 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the following st.



11. Work 1 BuSt in the next st.



10. Push the BuSt through to the front side of the work.



12. Work " 2 sc in the first st, 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st, 1 BuSt in the next st" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (36) There are 6 BuSt on this rnd.



Rnd 4:



1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



 Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 3 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (45)

Rnd 5:



1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 4 sts.



2. Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 4 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (54)



Rnd 6:



1. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts.



2. Work 1 BuSt in the next st.



3. Work 1 sc in the next 2 sts, followed by 1 BuSt in the next st.



4. Work "1 sc in the next 2 sts, 1 BuSt in the next st" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (54) There are 18 BuSt on this rnd.



Rnd 7:



1. Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the same st. Work 1 dc in the next 2 sts.



2. Work "2 dc in the next st, 1 dc in the next 2 sts" Repeat "-" to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st. (72)



The trivet on the left is what the piece will look like before felting. It measures approx. 9" in diameter. On the right, you can see the finished trivet after felting. The finished measurement depends on how much your washing machine felts the piece and can vary between 7"- 8" in diameter.
