



Rainbow rattle

Materials:

- Crochet hook 2,5 mm (UK size 12)
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4 – In 7 different colors
- 7 wooden beads 20 mm
- 7 wooden beads 15 mm
- 2 wooden rings 45 mm
- 50 cm polyester cord

Abbreviations:

Mr: Magic ring

St: Stitch / stitches

Sc: Single crochet

Sc2tog: Single crochet decrease (1 sc over 2 sc)

Colors used:

Color 1, coral 051

Color 2, peach 049

Color 3, soft yellow 053

Color 4, soft mint 025

Color 5, baby blue 032

Color 6, light purple 040

Color 7, white 001

Pattern:

Work a cover around each of the seven 20 mm wooden beads. Use one color for each bead.

1. Make a mr and work 6 sc in ring. (6)
2. 2 sc in each sc on entire round. (12)
3. Work "1 sc in first st and 2 sc in next st". Repeat "-" on entire round. (18)
4. 1 sc in every sc on entire round. (18)
5. 1 sc in every sc on entire round. (18)
6. 1 sc in every sc on entire round. (18) and place bead in cover. Now start closing the cover around the bead.



7. Work "1 sc in first st, sc2tog". Repeat "-" on entire round. (12)
8. Sc2tog on entire round. (6)

Cut the yarn, sew together and fasten tightly.



Assembly:

Important: When making your own toys and accessories - especially for babies - it's extremely important that you are extra thorough and careful with the assembly when having knots and loops.



1. Your rattle is now ready to assemble.



2. Cut your polyester cord with a length of approx. 50 cm. You may melt the ends a little to stop them from fraying.



3. Start by attaching the first 20 mm covered bead. You can insert the hook into the bead, so you can easily pull the cord through.



4. String the 15 mm and 20 mm beads alternately on to the cord as shown on the photo above.



5. Slip the two rings on the rattle.



6. And tie a firm knot.
