



# **Summer Hat - Child**

No. 2003-171-3326

### Materials:

16" (40 cm) Circular Needle US 2 ½ (3 mm) Crochet Hook 2.5 mm Plastic Wire 40 in. (100 cm)

#### Girl:

1 skein Soft, Go Handmade color 26 Boy: 1 skein Soft, Go Handmade color 30

## Sizes:

6-9 (12) 18-24 months

## Circumference:

18/19 (19 ¾) 19 ¾/ 20 ½ in. 46/48 (50) 50/52 cm

## Gauge:

28 sts per 4" (10 cm). 40 rows per 4" (10 cm).



#### Pattern

CO 8 sts. Divide the sts over 4 DPNs or use the magic loop method on the circular needle. Join in the rnd. Work increases on every other rnd = 8 increases per rnd.

All YOs are worked through the back loop to twist.

- 1. \*k1, YO \* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd.
- 2. k all sts
- 3. \*k2, YO \* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd.
- 4. k all sts
- 5. \*k3, YO \* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd.
- 6. k all sts

Continue increasing in this manner 8 (9) 10 times = 72 (80) 88 sts.

Work increases every 3<sup>rd</sup> row 2 times = 88 (96) 104 sts.

Continue working in the rnd evenly until the piece measures 4 (4  $\frac{3}{4}$ ) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$  in / 10 (12) 14 cm from the middle of the work.

#### Next Rnd:

Size 6-9 months: decrease 4 sts evenly = 84 sts

Size 12 months: k all sts = 96 sts

Size 18-24 months: increase 4 sts evenly = 108 sts

Bind off

#### **Girl Brim**

Pick up sts from the RS along the bind off edge.

- 1. Knit the first rnd through the back loop (tbl) to twist the sts, so the pick up sts don't have holes.
- 2. YO after every 7 (8) 9 sts = 12 sts increased.
- 3. k all sts, working tbl of the YOs.
- 4. YO after every 8 (9) 10 sts = 12 sts increased..
- 5. k all sts, working tbl of the YOs.

Continue increasing on every other row until the brim measures 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) 2 in. / 4 (4) 5 cm. Bind off, but do not cut the yarn.

Change to the 2.5mm crochet hook. Start by working 1 rnd of sl st to finish the bind off row nicely.

#### **Plastic Wire**

Work 1 rnd of sc over the plastic wire so that it is attached to the work. End with a sl st. Note: Trim the wire so that it fits the brim and can be taped together so that it overlaps.



#### Picot edge

Work 1 rnd of picot edge pattern \*ch 3, sc in the first ch, skip 2/3 sts, sc\* repeat to the end of the rnd. End with a sl st.

Weave in the ends.

#### **Boy Brim**

Pick up sts from the RS along the bind off edge.

- 1. Knit the first rnd through the back loop (tbl) to twist the sts, so the pick up sts don't have holes.
- 2. YO after every 7 (8) 9 sts = 12 sts increased.
- 3. k all sts, working tbl of the YOs.
- 4. YO after every 8 (9) 10 sts = 12 sts increased..
- 5. k all sts, working tbl of the YOs.

Continue increasing on every other row until the brim measures 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) 2 in. / 4 (4) 5 cm. Bind off, but do not cut the yarn.

Change to the 2.5mm crochet hook. Start by working 1 rnd of sl st to finish the bind off row nicely.

#### **Plastic Wire**

Work 1 rnd of sc over the plastic wire so that it is attached to the work. End with a sl st. Note: Trim the wire so that it fits the brim and can be taped together so that it overlaps. Weave in the ends
