



# Dreamy Shawl

## Materials:

2 skeins Dream colour, Hobbii color 05  
2 skeins Kid silk, Hobbii color 12

Circular needles 30", US 7 (4.5 mm)

## Pattern information:

Work is knit flat on circular needles

First knit the shawl and then pick up stitches to add the ruffle edge.

## Final Measurements:

Length: approx. 67 in.

Width: approx. 14 in.

## Shawl

CO 6 sts. Knit 1 row.

Increase section:

Row 1: sl 1 st purlwise, k1fb, k to the end of the row.

Row 2 – 4: sl 1 st purlwise, k to the end of the row.

Continue increasing in this manner until there are 65 sts on the needle.

Knit flat without increasing until the piece measures 28 inches from the last increase row.

Decrease section:

Row 1: sl 1 st purlwise, k2tog, k to the end of the row.

Row 2 – 4: sl 1 st purlwise, k to the end of the row.

Continue increasing in this manner until there are 6 sts remaining on the needle.

## Ruffle

Pick up sts along the edge of the shawl where the increases and decreases were made as show in the photo below.

Sl the first st purlwise on each row

Row 1: K through the back loop- twisting each st.

Row 2: \*K3, kfb\* Repeat \*-\* to the end of the row.

Row 3: K across all sts.

Row 4: \*K3, kfb\* Repeat \*-\* to the end of the row.

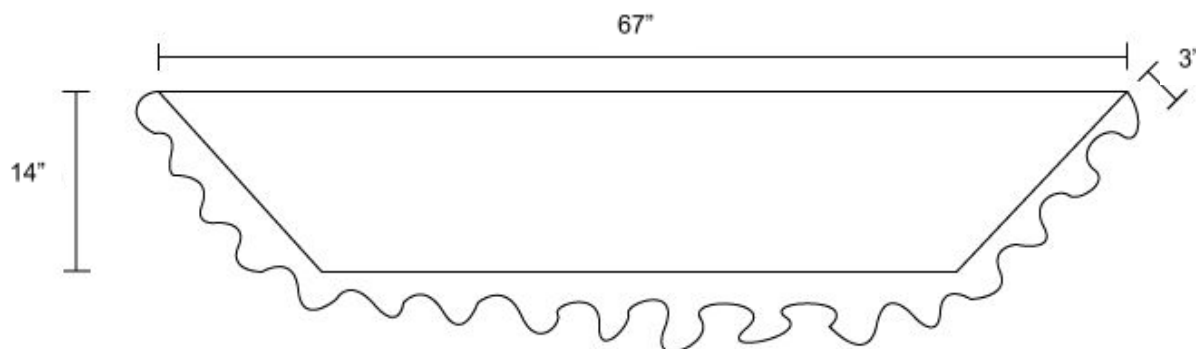
Row 5: K across all sts.

Row 6: \*K3, kfb\* Repeat \*-\* to the end of the row.

Row 7: K across all sts.

Continue knitting all sts until edge measures 3 inches.

Bind off in rib pattern \*k1, p1\* for a nice finished look. Weave in ends.
