



Pearl Jacket

No. 2003-183-7583

Materials:

2 (3) 3 skeins of baby merino, Hobbii no. 41
Circular needle size 4, 60 cm
Double ended needle size 4
Buttons, Ufo, dark, 15 mm

Size:

0-3 (6-9) 12-18 mth

Measurements:

Length: 8 (8.5) 9.5 inch
Width: 10 (10.5) 12 inch

Tension:

26 stitches = 4 inch
26 rows = 4 inch

Jacket

The first stitch on all rows is an edge stitch so slip this stitch. Knit the last stitch of every row.

Increases

Knit until 1 stitch before your marker, pick up the loop between your stitches and knit or purl it, according to the pattern, through the back of the loop.

Knitted in box stitch:

- 1st row - *Knit 2, purl 2*, repeat from * to *.
- 2nd row - *Knit on knit, purl on purl*, repeat from * to *.
- 3rd row - *Purl on knit, knit on purl*, repeat from * to *.
- 4th row - *Purl on purl, knit on knit*, repeat from * to *.

Repeat these 4 rows.

Body

Cast on 76 (81) 86 stitches on needle size 4.

1. Slip first stitch purl-wise. Purl the remainder of the row, turn.

Separate your work into front: 17 (18) 19, sleeve: 9 (10) 11, back: 24 (25) 26. Sleeve: 9 (10) 11, front: 17 (18) 19 stitches.

2. Slip the first stitch knit-wise. Box stitch *Knit 2, purl 2* until 1 stitch before the marker, increase by knitting 1 into the back of the loop between your stitches, knit 2, increase by knitting 1 into the back of the loop between your stitches. Increase in this way at every marker on all right-side rows = 8 increases.

Increase on all right-side rows until the raglan measures 3 (3.5) 4 inch.

SIMULTANEOUSLY make the button holes 6 (6) 7 times. First button hole is on row 4, then every 16th row.

Button hole

Slip first stitch purl-wise, 1 box stitch, 2 together according to the pattern, yarn over, finish the row according to pattern. Knit the next row as per the pattern and the button hole will appear.

Body

Leave the sleeve stitches for now and cast on 2 (2) 3 new stitches under each sleeve. On the first row knit through the back of the loop of the new stitches. After this, knit the new stitches normally to create a post down the side.

Continue back and forth using box stitch until your work measures 8 (8.5) 9.5 inch from the shoulder. Cast off in rib.

Sleeves

Pick the sleeve stitches back up. Knit 2 (2) 3 stitches under the sleeve in the increase stitches from the body. Mark the middle stitch(s) under the sleeve. Knit this/ these stitches on all rounds. Continue round using the box stitch.

Decrease every 0.8 inch by continuing until 2 stitches before the marked stitches. Knit 2 stitches together through the back loops, knit the marker stitch(s), knit 2 stitches together through the back loops.

Continue until the sleeve measures 3.5 (4.7) 5 inch from the armpit. Purl 1 round.

Cast off in rib and fasten ends.

Sew on buttons.
