

## Retro pot holders

## Materials:

- Crochet hook 2,5 mm (US B-1)
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4 or Rainbow Cotton 8/4 print
- Leather string for straps

Measurements: approx. $20 \times 21,5 \mathrm{~cm}$
Usage: approx. 90 g per set

## Abbreviations:

Mr: magic ring
Ch: chain stitch
St: stitch(es)
Sc: single crochet
Dc: double crochet
Sl st: slip stitch
WS: wrong side

## Pattern: - You can also follow the photo guide below

1. Start by making a mr. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1 . Then work " 3 dc , ch $1^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat from "to" 5 times. Pull lightly on your mr to tighten. Finish the round with 1 sl st in $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$.
2. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space. Then work " 3 dc , ch 1, 3 dc around next ch-space". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
3. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space. Work 4 dc around next ch-space. Then work " 3 dc , ch 1, 3 dc around next ch-space and 4 dc around the following ch-space". Repeat from "to" a total of 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
4. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1,3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $2 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip 3 st , 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $2 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
5. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1,3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $4 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " 3 dc ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip 3 st , 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next 4 st , 2 dc in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
6. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc ch 1,3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $6 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next 6 st, 2 dc in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
7. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }}$ dc). Work 2 dc , ch 1,3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $8 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " 3 dc ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next 8 st , 2 dc in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times. Finish with 1 sl st.
8. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1,3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $10 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $10 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
9. Work sl st to first ch-space. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1, 3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $12 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $12 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
Make 3 more in the same way.


## Assembly -You can also follow the photo guide below:

Place front on back, WS against WS and work the parts together as follows:

1. Begin by inserting the yarn in a ch-space and work through both layers. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch 1, 3 dc around ch-space. Skip 3 st , 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $14 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st. Then work " 3 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next ch-space, skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $14 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st". Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.
2. Ch 1 . Work a round of sc around the entire potholder. Work 2 sc in each ch-space and finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Attach 1 leather string to each potholder as strap as shown on the photos below.


## Instruction:

## Round 1



1. Begin by making a mr. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc and ch 1 . Now work" 3 dc and ch 1 ". Repeat from "to" 5 times. Pull lightly on your mr to tighten and finish with 1 sl st.

## Round 2



1. Work sl st to first ch-space.

2. Now work in next ch-space:

3. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

4. "3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc around ch-space".

5. Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

## Round 3



1. Work sl st to first ch-space.

2. Work 4 dc around next ch-space.

3. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

4. Like this.

5. "3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc around next ch-space,

6. Repeat from "to" a total of 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

## Round 4



1. Work sl st to first ch-space.

2. And 4 dc around the following ch-space".

3. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

4. Skip 3 st. And work 2 dc in next st.

5. 1 dc in each of the next 2 st .

6. Like this.

7. Like this.

8. And 2 dc in next st.

9. Then work " 3 dc, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next chspace,

10. Skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $2 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st".

## Round 5:



1. Work sl st to first ch-space.

2. Skip 3 st,

3. Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

4. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }}$ dc). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

5. And work 2 dc in next st.

6. Work 1 dc in each of the next 4 st.

7. Like this.

8. Skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $4 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st".

9. And 2 dc in the next st.

10. Then work " 3 dc, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around next chspace,
11. Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

## Round 6 and forward:



1. Repeat the rounds as described in the pattern.

## Instruction - Assembly:

## Round 1



1. Place front on back, WS against WS and work the parts together as follows:

2. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

3. Insert the yarn in a ch-space and work through both layers.

4. Skip 3 st,

5. Work 2 dc in next st,

6. 2 dc in next st.

7. Ch 3 (replaces $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ ). Work 2 dc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ around ch-space.

8. 1 dc in each of the next 14 st ,

9. Like this.

10. Skip $3 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, 1 dc in each of the next $14 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st".

11. Repeat from "to" 5 times and finish with 1 sl st.

## Round 2



1. Ch 1 . Work a round of sc around the entire potholder. Work 2 sc in each ch-space and finish with 1 sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

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
