



# Peacock Shawl in Kid Silk

## Materials

4 balls Kid Silk, color 19

Single pointed needles 6 mm / US 10

Blocking mats

Blocking wires

T pins

## Yarn information

**Kid Silk**, Hobbii

70% Kid Mohair, 30% Silk

25 g = 195 meter / 0.9 oz = 213 yds

## Gauge

1 repeat of pattern in width measures 10 cm

= 18 st x 22 rows

## Measurements

Ca. 110 x 110 cm

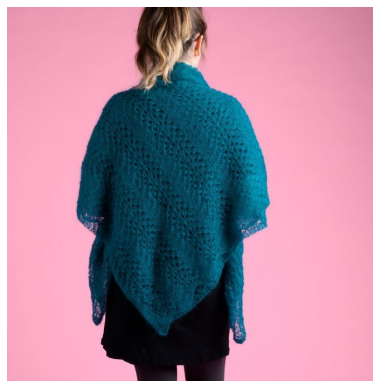
## Pattern information

This shawl is worked on larger needles than stated on the yarn label.

After finishing the shawl, you soak and block it into the right shape using blocking mats, blocking wires and T pins.

## Hashtags for social media

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### PEACOCK PATTERN (aka wave pattern)

Row 1: k all st

Row 2: p all st

Row 3: (k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, \*(k2tog) 6 times, (yo, k1) 6 times\*, repeat from \* to \* until 6 st remains, (k2tog) 3 times.

Row 4: k all st

### PATTERN

CO 202 st and work 3 rows in garter st.

K2 (= edge st) and work the peacock pattern beg with 3<sup>rd</sup> row of pattern until 2 st remains, k2 (= edge st) = 11 repeats of pattern.

Continue working the pattern until the shawl measures approx. 110 cm. Finish with 3<sup>rd</sup> row of pattern.

Work 2 rows in garter st and bind off all st.

### FINISH

Block the shawl into shape using blocking mats, blocking wires and T pins.

This way ensures the most beautiful result.
