Chanel on cosy blanket and wooden ring

Materials

Cosy blanket 22 x 22 cm

Chanel on wooden ring 12 cm

Teddy yarn: 100 g

Vintage yarn: 50 g

Crochet hook 2,0 - 3,0 mm

Crochet hook cosy blanket: 4,0 - 5,0 mm

Wooden ring: 68 mm

Eyes: 8 mm

Stuffing



Crocheted in Go handmades Teddy:
100% Polyester, 50 g/65 m and Go handmades
Vintage: 70% Wool/30% Bamboo, 25 g/60 m.





MATERIALS:

CHANEL – ON COSY BLANKET

15 g brown Go Handmade Vintage Yarn
75 g beige Go Handmade Teddy Yarn
Embroidery yarn
2 eyes 8 mm
Stuffing
Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm
Crochet hook size 4,0 - 5,0 mm (for the blanket)

CHANEL - ON WOODEN RING

15 g brown Go Handmade Vintage Yarn
15 g beige Go Handmade Teddy Yarn
Embroidery yarn
2 eyes 8 mm
Wooden ring 68 mm
Stuffing
Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm

CHANEL – PÅ MOBILE (1)

7 g brown Go Handmade Vintage Yarn
7 g beige Go Handmade Teddy Yarn
Embroidery yarn
2 eyes 8 mm
Stuffing
Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm

All yarn lengths are estimates and depend on crocheting style.

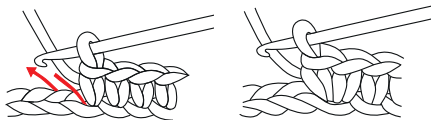
ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Centre ring (2 ch, work the specified number of stitches into the second stitch from the hook)
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, 1 ch then turn the work
dc	Double crochet
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
{...} to end	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated
(..)	for the whole round/row
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches

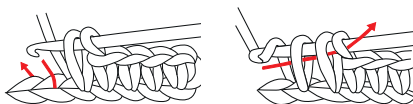
If nothing else is specified, spiral rounds are worked. To finish the work, join the round with one ch. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

Start with Vintage yarn.

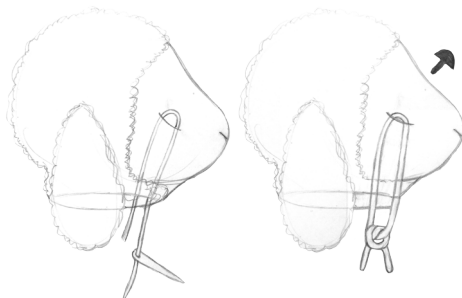
Cut the yarn, pull the yarn through the stitches, pull the together and sew the head together except for a small opening. Stuff the head with toy stuffing.

Shape the head and eye sockets by drawing a thread from the head's opening (where it will be sewn onto the cosy blanket) to the placement of one of the eyes, lead the thread around a stitch, and back again. Tighten the thread to form an eye socket, and fix the thread ends by tying a knot. Repeat on the other eye. See ill.

Attach the safety eyes in row 8 and space them with approx. 9 stitches in between. The discs for the eyes are inserted from the inside, push them firmly, perhaps by using a coin. Close the last opening.

Embroider a "Y" as a snout.

Sew the head onto the cosy blanket.



EAR (2 X)

Crochet with Vintage yarn.

| 6.) | 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc,
2 dc, 2 dc inc, 5 dc | (15) |

Compress the ear slightly at the opening, and fasten it on the side of the head at the same level as the eyes.

ARM (2 X)

Start with Vintage yarn.

2 dc, 3 dc in last st. Continue on
the other side of the length of ch sts
with 2 dc, 2 dc in next st | (11) |

3. - 7.) 12 dc (12)
 8.) dc 2 tog, 4 dc, dc 2 tog, 4 dc (10)
 9.) 10 dc (10)

Change to Teddy yarn.

10. - 20.) 10 dc (10)
 21.) t-ch, 5 dc (5)
 22.) t-ch, 5 dc (5)

Fill the arms with toy stuffing.

Use the yarn end to sew the arms onto the blanket.

COSY BLANKET

Crochet with Teddy yarn.

The cosy blanket is crocheted like a grandmother's square as follows.

Each round starts with 3 ch, which replaces the 1st tr.
 Finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch in the start of the round.

- 1.) cr, {3 tr, 2 ch} i the ring x 4
 2.) {3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch} in each corner x 4
 3.) 3 sl st to the corner.
 {3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch in the corner group.
 3 tr, 2 ch in the ch-loop} x 4
 4. - 8.) Crochet as round 3, which increases with 1 tr-group + 2 ch in the ch-loops

Continue to the desired size.

In this recipe there are 8 rounds with approx. dimensions of 22 x 22 cm.

Weave in the ends.

CHANEL – ON WOODEN RING

HEAD

Start with Vintage yarn.

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
 2.) 2 dc in each st (12)
 3.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (18)
 4.) 18 dc (18)
 5.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (24)
 6.) 24 dc (24)
 7.) {3 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (30)
 8.) {9 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (33)
 9.) 33 dc (33)
 10.) 12 dc, 9 x 2 dc inc, 12 dc (42)

Change to Teddy yarn.

11. - 14.) 42 dc (42)
 15.) {5 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (36)
 16.) {4 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (30)
 17.) {3 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (24)
 18.) 24 dc (24)
 19.) {2 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (18)
 20.) {1 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (12)
 21.) {dc 2 tog} to end (6)

The head is made the same way as the head on 'cosy blanket'.

UK

EAR (2 X)

Crochet with Vintage yarn.

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
 2.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (6)
 3.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (8)
 4.) {3 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (10)
 5.) {4 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (12)
 6.) 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 5 dc (15)
 7. - 11.) 15 dc (15)



Compress the ear slightly at the opening, and fasten it on the side of the head at the same level as the eyes.

RING-COVER

Crochet with Vintage yarn.

- 1.) 21 ch, turn the work (21)
- 2.) 1 dc in 2nd ch from the hook, crochet 20 dc till the end, turn the work (20)
3. - 11.) 1 ch, crochet 20 dc till the end. Turn the work after each row (20)

Sew the cover onto the wooden ring with the yarn end. Sew the head onto the ring.

ARM (2 X)

Start with Vintage yarn.

- 1.) Work 5 ch.
2 dc in 2nd st from the hook,
2 dc, 3 dc in last st. Continue on
the other side of the length of ch sts
with 2 dc, 2 dc in next st (11)
- 2.) 5 dc, 2 dc inc, 5 dc (12)
3. - 7.) 12 dc (12)
- 8.) dc 2 tog, 4 dc, dc 2 tog, 4 dc (10)
- 9.) 10 dc (10)

Change to Teddy yarn.

10. - 20.) 10 dc (10)
- 21.) t-ch, 5 dc (5)
- 22.) t-ch, 5 dc (5)

Fill the arms with toy stuffing.

Use the yarn end to sew the arms onto the ring.

CHANEL – ON MOBILE

HEAD

Start with Vintage yarn.

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
- 2.) 2 dc in each st (12)
- 3.) {1 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (18)
- 4.) 18 dc (18)
- 5.) {2 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (24)
- 6.) 24 dc (24)
- 7.) {3 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (30)
- 8.) {9 dc, 2 dc inc} to end (33)
- 9.) 33 dc (33)
- 10.) 12 dc, 9 x 2 dc inc, 12 dc (42)

Change to Teddy yarn.

11. - 14.) 42 dc (42)
- 15.) {5 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (36)
- 16.) {4 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (30)
- 17.) {3 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (24)
- 18.) 24 dc (24)
- 19.) {2 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (18)
- 20.) {1 dc, dc 2 tog} to end (12)
- 21.) {dc 2 tog} to end (6)

The head is made the same way as the head on 'cosy blanket'.

EAR (2 X)

The ear is made the same way as on the 'cosy blanket'.

SCARF

Crochet with Teddy yarn.

- 1.) Work 25 ch,
turn the work and make 24 dc

Fasten it on the head.



Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
