

## Ribbon Basket - Oval

## Materials:

- Crochet hook H ( 5.0 mm )- L ( 8.0 mm ) See the gauge section for more info.
- Hobbii Ribbon 75 g (small) or 130 g (large)
- Leather strap- $3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4$ " - Natural (large)
- Leather strap $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 2"- Natural (small)
- 2 rivets
- Leather working punch


## Size:

Large:
Base= approx. $71 / 2$ " x $33 / 4$ "
Height= approx. $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Small:

Base= approx. $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Height= approx. $23 / 4$ "

## Abbreviations:

ch: chain stitch
st: stitch
sc: single crochet
long- sc: long single crochet- Skip two previous rows, insert hook in sc in next row, pull up long lp, yo, draw through both lps on hook
BL: back loop
Sl st: slip stitch

## Gauge:

The pattern is written for a crochet hook H ( 5.0 mm ), but the size can be adjusted by using a larger or smaller hook. If the hook is too small, the base of the basket will begin to curve forming a bowl shape, in this case you should go up to a larger hook.

## Pattern - There is a photo tutorial at the end of the written pattern.

## Small:

Work in the round.

1. Ch 9 . Work 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook. Work 1 sc in the next 6 sts. In the last st, work 3 sc . Now work into the back loop of the starting ch sts. Work 1 sc in the next 6 sts. In the last st, work 1 sc. (18)
2. Work 2 sc in each of the first 2 sts, 1 sc in the next $6 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of the next $3 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next 6 sts. In the last st, work 2 sc. (24)
3. Work 2 sc in each of the first $2 \mathrm{sts}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next $\mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next st.

Work 1 sc in the next 6 sts. For the next 6 sts work: 2 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc, 2 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc.
Work 1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st and 1 sc in the last st. (32)
4. For the first 6 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$.

Work 1 sc in the next 8 sts.
For the next 8 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$.
Work 1 sc in the last 10 sts. (39)
5. Work 1 round of $s c$ in the BL of each st. (39)
6. Work ${ }^{*} 1$ sc in the next st, 1 long-sc in the next st*. Repeat *-* to the last st ending with 1 sc .
7. Work *1 long-sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next st* Repeat *-* to the last st ending with 1 long-sc. Repeat rows 6 and 7 until you reach the desired height of the basket. End with 1 round of sl st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.

## Large:

Work in the round.

1. Ch 15 . Work 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from the hook. Work 1 sc in the next 12 sts. In the last st, work 3 sc . Now work into the back loop of the starting ch sts. Work 1 sc in the next 12 sts. In the last st work 1 sc. (30)
2. Work 2 sc in each of the first 2 sts, 1 sc in the next 12 sts. Work 2 sc in each of the next 3 sts. Work 1 sc in the next 12 sts and 2 sc in the last st. (36)
3. Work 2 sc in each of the first 2 sts, 1 sc in the next st, 2 sc in the next st.

Work 1 sc in the next 12 sts. For the next 6 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$. Work 1 sc in the next 12 sts, 2 sc in the next st and 1 sc in the last st. (44)

4. For the first 6 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$.

Work 1 sc in the next 14 sts.
For the next 8 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$.
Work 1 sc in the next 14 sts, 2 sc in the next st and 1 sc in the last st. (52)
5. For the first 8 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next $4 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$. Work 1 sc in the next 16 sts.

For the next 10 sts work: $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next $4 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$.
Work 1 sc in the last 18 sts. (59)
6. Work 1 round of sc in the BL of each st. (59)
7. Work ${ }^{*} 1$ sc in the next st, 1 long-sc in the next st*. Repeat *-* to the last st ending with 1 sc .
8. Work *1 long-sc in the next st, 1 sc in the next st* Repeat *-* to the last st ending with 1 long-sc.

Repeat rounds 7 and 8 until you have 11 rounds in all where you alternate sc and long-sc, or until you reach the desired height.

End with 1 round of sl st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.

## Photo Tutorial:



1. The base should like like this when completed.

2. Like this.

3. Work 1 round of sc in the BL of each st. The needle is showing where to insert the hook for the BL.

4. Repeat around all sts.

5. The next round alternates from sc and longsc. Start with 1 sc in the first st.

6. Like this. There is now 1 long-sc completed.

7. Work 1 long-sc. The needle is showing where to insert the hook.


The next st is a long-sc. . The needle is showing where to insert the hook for this.

7. 1 sc in the next st.

9. Like this.

10. Repeat to the last st ending with 1 sc.

12. Like this.

14. Repeat to the last st ending with 1 long-sc.

11. On the next round, work *long-sc, sc* around. The needle is showing where to insert the hook for the first long-sc.

13. Work 1 sc in the next st.

15. Repeat these 2 rows until you reach your desired height for the basket. End with 1 round of sl st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.

## Attaching the leather strap:



Cut the piece of leather to the right size. Make a hole in each end for the rivet.


Set the leather strap over the edge of the basket and secure with the rivet.
