Model: Chanel Stitch. Size: 18,5 x 6 x H 12,5 cm/Cosy yarn* 150 g. Size: 22 x 6 x H 16 cm/Cosy yarn* 250 g. *Double thread: 15 htr/10 cm. Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,5 mm.

GOOD TO KNOW ABOUT THE PATTERN

Hook, size and gauge

This pattern should be crocheted rather tightly to obtain the desired aspect.

Be aware that the final size may vary with a couple of cm more or less depending on your gauge. If you find the gauge of this pattern challenging, we recommend to use the measuring tape regularly.

Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,5 cm

Gauge: 15 htr equals 10 cm

Small size.: 18,5 x 6 x H 12,5 cm

Base

Crochet a foundation chain of 28 ch.

Crochet in rows.

1.) Start at the 2nd ch after the hook and crochet 27 htr. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.

Rows 2 to 43 start in 3rd st from the hook.

- 2. 13.) 1 htr in every st. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 14.) 1 htr in every bl. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 15. 20.) 1 htr in every st. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 21.) 1 htr in every fl. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 22. 33.) 1 htr in every st. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 34.) 1 htr in every bl. (27) Finish with 2 t-ch.
- 35. 37.) 1 htr in every st. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 1 htr in every bl. (27)
 Finish with 2 t ch.
- 39. 42.) 1 htr in every st. (27) Finish with 2 t - ch.

Finish and cut, weave in ends – the base is done.

Crochet from bottom to top.

Crochet a foundation chain of 11 ch.

Crochet in rows.

2 6.)	Start in 3rd st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (1 Finish with 2 t-ch.	0)
7.)	Start in 4th st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (9 Finish with 2 t - ch.	?)
8.)	Start in 4th st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (8 Finish with 2 t - ch.	5)
9.)	Start in 3rd st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (8 Finish with 2 t - ch.	3)
10.)	Start in 4rd st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (7 Finish with 2 t - ch.	7)
11.)	Start in 4th st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (6 Finish with 2 t - ch.)
12.)	Start in 3rd st from hook, 1 htr in every st. (6	5)

Finish and cut, weave in ends. Cut approx. 100 cm of yarn for assembly. The first side is done – work the other side the same way.

Chanel Stitch Handbag

Big size: $22 \times 6 \times H \ 16 \text{ cm}$

Base

Crochet a foundation chain of 34 ch.

Crochet in rows.

 Start at the 2nd ch from hook and crochet 33 htr. (33) Finish with 2 t-ch.

From row 2 to 57 start in the 3rd st from hook.

- 2. 17.) 1 htr in every st. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 18.) 1 htr in every bl. (33) Finish with 2 t-ch.
- 19. 24.) 1 htr in every st. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 25.) 1 htr in every fl. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 26. 41.) 1 htr in every st. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 42.) 1 htr in every bl. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 43. 45.) 1 htr in every st. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 46.) 1 htr in every bl. (33) Finish with 2 t-ch.
- 47. 54.) 1 htr in every st. (33) Finish with 2 t - ch.
- 55.) 1 htr in every st. (33)

Finish and cut, weave in ends – the base is done.

Side (2 x)

Crochet from bottom to top.

Crochet a foundation chain of 11 ch.

Crochet in rows.

Finish and cut, weave in ends. Cut approx. 100 cm of yarn for assembly. The first side is done – work the other side the same way.

Assembling the side pieces

Sew the side pieces onto the base with single thread.

Turn the side piece with the narrow piece upward. Start sewing from the top corner of the side piece with outer stitches. Sew down the side, down the bottom and up the other side, to the second top corner of the side piece. Keep in mind that the stitches need to be placed opposite each other.

The bag is finished and ready for addition of various accessories, lining (see pages 10 - 11), zippers, straps, etc.



Mounting the lock

Push the lock into the edge of the flap of the bag. Attach the 2 screws to the back (inside).

The other part has "legs" on the back. Note that the small lock has 2 "legs", while the larger lock has 4 "legs". Put the "legs" through the front of the bag to fit the location of the first part of the lock. Place the supplied mounting plate over the 2 "legs" and bend "legs" towards each other. If there are more than 2 "legs", repeat the process (photo 2).

The mounting of the lock is complete.



Universal sewing instructions for bag lining and zipper pockets

Always read the whole description before you start – it contains details that are important for your full understanding

Lining for the bag:

- Put the bag on the lining fabric and draw the outline of the bag with chalk or a pencil. Cut around the drawn line - cut two equal pieces, so you have two pieces/ sides, both the same size. Note: If the bag is to have a base then the height of the fabric must be adjusted accordingly.
- 2. Sew three sides together with backstitches. If your bag has a base, a "flat" piece in the bottom, add this to the height of the fabric before cutting. It may be an advantage to wait with the final cut of the lining fabric until the base has been sewn together.
- 3. Make the base as follows: Put the already sewn lining fabric on a flat surface (picture 3) and in each of the two sewn corners 'pull' the fabric away from the corner now the fabric forms a 'flat' piece and a 'triangle' (picture 4). Stitch the triangle down at the desired location depending on the size of base you want (choose how many centimetres in). When you have sewn both triangles you have your base (picture 5).
- 4. When you base is completed it is a good idea to place the lining into the bag to correctly measure the required length. Let the fabric line the bag and cut at the desired height. Before cutting it is also possible to take into consideration a folded edge. This will give a nice transition inside the bag. Sew the lining on with invisible stitches.



Zip locked pocket inside the bag:

- 5. A pocket is made of two pieces (equal size) of lining fabric, sewn together on three sides.
- 6. Sew the back of the zipper to the front of one of the pieces of fabric. Fold the edge of the other piece so that the two pieces are placed right side against right side and still are equal in size. The pocket is now finished. hinanden og er lige store.

Placing the pocket in the lining of the bag:

- 7. Put the pocket where you would like it to be, attach it to the lining with pins, then draw a line where you want the opening of the zipper. The opening can be shorter than the zipper; the extra part of the zipper will then be inside the pocket.
- 8. Cut the fabric where the marking for the opening is. Cut two small 'notches' of approx. half a centimeter from each end of the opening (in the open piece that the zipper should be in) - this is to make the area look nicer.
- 9. Fold the 'notches' back (picture 6).
- Add the pocket, with the zipper upwards, onto the underside of the bag so that it fits with the opening in the lining. Sew on using backstitches (picture 7-8).

You have now made the lining with a zip locked pocket. Attach the lining to the bag with invisible stitches.

Hook Size & Gauge

The Chanel Stitch bag are crocheted to meet what we find is a rather tightly tightness. The gauge that we think best suits the bag.

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us for all our bags. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook.

Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes up to: 3,5 - 4,5 mm.

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
