

## Cone Ornament

No. 2003-184-5206

## Materials:

DPN $21 / 2(3.0 \mathrm{~mm})$
Crochet Hook C ( 2.75 mm )
1 skein Soft Alpaca, color 10

Buy the yarn here:

Knitting gauge:
26 sts $\times 30$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$
Pattern information:
The cones are adjustable so you can make it how you like it best.

Finish with a crocheted picot edge and a handle made from either chain sts or foundationless single crochet or add a leather strap instead.

Knit from the bottom up.

## Cone

Cast on 4 sts. Divide onto 4 DPNs. Fordel maskerne på fire pinde. All YO are k tbl.

Round 1: *k1, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Round 2: Knit all sts.
Round 3: *k2, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Round 4: *k3, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Rounds 5 \& 6: Knit all sts.
Round 7: *k4, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Rounds 8-12: Knit all sts.
Round 13: *k5, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Rounds 14 - 19: Knit all sts.
Round 20: *k6, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Rounds 21 - 26: Knit all sts.
Round 27: *k7, YO* repeat *-* across all sts.
Round 28 - 33: Knit all sts.

Bind off loosely. Do not cut the yarn, but place the last stitch on the crochet hook and work a picot edge.

## Picot edge

The edge is worked from the outside across all stitches.
Work: Ch 3, sl st in the first ch-st, secure bobble with sc in every other st from the edge of the cone.

## Handle

Crochet a handle with 50 ch-stitches. Attach to the other side of the cone with a sc in the edge.
