



# **Birch - Crocheted Hat**

# MATERIALS

2 skeins of 1.8 oz (50 g) Simple Wool color no.12Crochet hook size H/8 (5 mm)Stitch markers

#### SIZES S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS Circumference: 20.5 (21.7) 22.8 inches (52 (55) 58 cm) – it will stretch in its width Length: approx. 9 (9) 9.4 inches (23 (23) 24 cm)

GAUGE 16 stitches per 4 inches (10 cm) in single crochet stitches

#### EXPLANATION

Single crochet stitch: insert the hook through the next stitch, yarn over and pull back, yarn over and pull back through the two loops on the hook.

Half double crochet stitch: yarn over, insert the hook through the next stitch, yarn over and pull back = 3 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull back through the 3 loops.

2 half double crochet stitches together: yarn over, insert your hook through the next stitch, yarn over and pull back = 3 loops on your hook, insert the hook through the next stitch, yarn over and pull back = 4 loops on your hook, yarn over and pull back through the 4 loops on the hook.



# Edge

Chain 82 (88) 94 stitches.
Join the foundation chain to a ring with a slip stitch.
1. Round: work 1 sc in each ch.
2. Round: work 1 sc in each sc.
Place a marker at the beginning of the round.
Repeat round 2 until the edge measures 1.6 inches (4 cm). *NOTE: try to see if the edge of the hat fits your size.*Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

# Work 1 round with increases:

# <u>Size S:</u>

Work \*12 sc, work 2 sc in the next stitch\*, repeat from \*-\* 6 times, work till the end of the round = 88 stitches

# <u>Size M:</u>

Work \*10 sc, work 2 sc in the next stitch\*, repeat from \*-\* 8 times, work till the end of the round = 96 stitches

# <u>Size L:</u>

Work \*8 sc, work 2 sc in the next stitch\*, repeat from \*-\* 10 times, work till the end of the round = 104 stitches

# Continue crocheting the hat in a pattern

- 1. Round: work 1 hdc in each sc.
- 2. Round: work 1 hdc (in the 2 back loops only) in each hdc.
- A raised line / crease will appear on the right side.
- Repeat the 2. round until the hat measures approx. 5.5 inches (14 cm).

# Start decreasing

<u>Size S</u>: Work \*20 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from \*-\* 4 times = 84 stitches.

<u>Size M:</u> Work \*6 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from\*-\* 12 times = 84 stitches.

<u>Size L:</u> Work \*11 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from \*-\* 8 times = 96 stitches. Work 1 round without any decreases.

Work \*6 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from \*-\* 12 times = 84 stitches.



#### All sizes:

Work 1 round without any decreases. Now, you have 84 stitches in total in each size.

# Continue decreasing every 2nd round:

1. Round: work \*5 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from \*-\* 12 times = 72 stitches.

3. Round: work \*4 hdc, 2 hdc together\*, repeat from \*-\* 12 times = 60 stitches.

Continue with 1 stitch less between the decreases every 2nd round until you have 12 stitches.

Hereafter, work 2 hdc together 6 times.

# Finish

Fasten off and sew the yarn end through the stitches, pull tight so the hole closes and weave in the end.
