



# **Starlight moss stitch sweater**

# Materials:

8 (9) 10 (10) 11 (12) balls of 50 g Starlight col. 04 Double pointed needles size 5 and 5,5 mm Circular needle size 5 and 5,5 mm, 80 cm

#### Sizes:

2 (4) 6 (8) 10 (12) years

MEASUREMENTS Width: 31 (33) 36 (38) 39 (41) cm Length: 37 (40) 45 (49) 53 (57) cm

### Gauge:

15 stitches on 10 cm 21 rows on 10 cm

# Pattern information:

The sweater is worked bottom up. Body and sleeves are slipped on one circular needle. Hereafter you increase for the raglan on the yoke.

#### Abbreviation

Inc one stitch: Pick up the yarn between two stitches and knit it through back loop (tbl).



**Moss stitch:** \*k1, p1I\*. Repeat from \* - \* on entire round. Here after you purl over knit and knit over purl.

## Jumper

**Rib edge:** CO 92 (100) 108 (114) 118 (124) stitches on circular needle size 5 mm and work in the round.

Work 5 cm twisted rib: \*k1 tbl, p1\*. Repeat from \* - \* on entire round.

**Jumper**: Change to circular needle size 5,5 mm and inc 1 st on the  $1^{st}$  round = 93 (101) 109 (115) 119 (125) stitches. When you have an uneven number of stitches, you can work in the round and continue working the moss stitch with purl over knit and knit over purl. Continue in moss stitch until the piece measures 23 (26) 29 (32) 35 (38) cm.

Insert a marker at the beginning of the round.

**Armhole:** Work until 3 (3) 5 (5) 7 (7) stitches before the marker, BO 3 (3) 5 (5) 7 (7) stitches, work 43 (47) 49 (52) 52 (55) stitches for the front piece, BO 3 (3) 5 (5) 7 (7) stitches = 44 (48) 50 (53) 53 (56) stitches for the back piece.

Put the piece aside and work both sleeves.

# Sleeves

**Rib edge**: CO 28 (28) 30 (32) 34 (34) stitches on double pointed needles size 5 mm and work in the round.

Work 3 cm twisted rib: \*k1 tbl, p1\*. Repeat from \* - \* on entire round.

**Sleeve**: Change to double pointed needles size 5,5 mm. Insert a marker at the beginning of the round. Work 1 st on each side of the marker in stockinette stitch = sleeve seam. The rest is worked in moss stitch.

Work 2 cm like this. Finish at the beginning of the round.

**Begin increasing:** k1, inc 1 stitch, work until 1 stitch before the marker, inc 1 stitch, k1 = 2 stitches increased.

Increase in moss stitch on every  $6^{th}$  round until there are 34 (38) 42 (46) 50 (52) stitches. Continue until the sleeve measures 28 (31) 34 (37) 39 (40) cm. Finish the round 2 (2) 3 (3) 4 (4) stitches before the marker. BO 3 (3) 5 (5) 7 (7) stitches = 31 (35) 37 (41) 43 (45) stitches. Put the sleeve aside and work the other sleeve in the same way.

#### Yoke

Slip all pieces on to the circular needle and continue in moss stitch.

Add the sleeves to the sweater like this: sleeve, front piece, sleeve, back piece, (increase 1 stitch on the back piece = 148 (164) 172 (186) 190 (200) stitches.

Insert a marker in each transition (raglan seam) and work 1 stitch in stockinette stitch on each side of the seam (as on the sleeves), work the rest of the stitches in moss stitch. Work 1 round and finish at the beginning of the round.

**Begin decreasing for the raglan:** k1, k2tog, \*work moss stitch until 3 stitches before the next marker, k2tog, k2, k2tog\*, repeat from \* - \* a total of 3 times, work moss stitch until 3 stitches before last marker, k2tog, k1 = 8 stitches decreased.

Continue decreasing like this in every 2<sup>nd</sup> round until there are 68 (68) 68 (74) 78 (80) stitches left.



#### Neck edge

Change to double pointed needles size 5 mm and work the twisted rib edge as follows: \*k1 tbl and p1\*, repeat \*-\* on entire round. Continue until the edge measures 6 cm. BO loosely in rib.

### Finish

Fold the neck edge double and sew it on to the WS of the sweater. Sew the openings under the sleeves together.
