



Starlight Ribbed Hat

No. 2003-184-9397

Materials

32" Circular needle US 8 (5 mm)

2 (3) 3 skeins of 50 g Starlight color 08

Sizes

S (M) L

Measurements

14 (15 $\frac{3}{4}$) 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ in.

Fits head size: 21 $\frac{1}{4}$ (22) 22 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.

Gauge

22 sts = 4" in rib pattern.

22 rows = 4"

Pattern information

The hat is knit from the bottom up using the magic loop technique with a circular needle.

Hat

CO 80 (88) 96 sts.

Knit 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ (6 $\frac{3}{4}$) 7 inches in rib *p2, k2*.

Decreasing

Decrease on every other rnd.

1. Rnd. 1: *p2tog, k2, p2, k2* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
2. Rnd 2: knit in pattern as established. (purl the purl sts, knit the knit sts)
3. Rnd 3: *p1, k2, p2tog, k2* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
4. Rnd 4: knit in pattern as established.
5. Rnd 5: *p1, k2tog, p1, k2* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
6. Rnd 6: knit in pattern as established
7. Rnd 7: *p1, k1, p1, k2tog* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
8. Rnd 8: knit in pattern as established.
9. Rnd 9: *k2tog* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.
10. Rnd 10: Knit all sts
11. Rnd 11: *k2tog* - repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Cut the yarn and pull through the remaining sts. Pull tight and weave in ends.
