



Malene Poncho - Child

Materials

5 skeins of 50 g Soft Alpaca color 11

Circular needles US 10 ½ (6.5mm): 32"

Measurement

Width: 17,7 inches (45 cm)

Length: 17,7 inches (45 cm)

Gauge

18 sts = 4" of unstretched rib pattern and holding 2 strands of yarn.

Pattern information

The poncho is knit holding 2 strands together. You will knit a piece approx. 35,4" (90 cm) wide that will be folded in half and then knit together along the shoulder and neck.

Explanation

1 edge-st: Slip 1 st purlwise, work to the last st, k1.

Pattern

Cast on 161 sts loosely holding 2 strands of yarn together. Knit flat on circular needle.

Work rib pattern: 1 edge-st, *p1,k1* across. Continue to follow the established pattern, working 1 edge-st at the beginning of each row and ending with a k1. until the piece measures 17,7 inches.

Finishing

Fold piece in half lining up the edge. Using a 3-needle bind off technique, join the edges together and bind off until there are approx. 81 sts remaining. Bind off remaining sts in rib pattern (single layer) to form the neck hole.
