



Bungee Project Tray

Materials:

- Crochet hook size 10 mm / US N/15
- Bungee Mini
- Leather strap 25 mm Natural
- 4 stk. rivets 6-9 mm

Measurements:

Bottom: approx. 35 cm. Height: approx.. 10 cm.

Usage approx.: 600g (3 balls)

Abbreviations:

Ch: chain stitch

St: stitch(es)

Sc: single crochet

Sl st: slip stitch

Mr: magic ring

BLO: back loop only

Lsc: long single crochet (aka spike

stitch)



Pattern - You can also find a picture guide below.

NB: You can shift your increases on each round to avoid edges and creating a neat, round bottom.

- 1. Make a mr and work 6 sc in ring. Finish with 1 sl st. (6)
- 2. Ch 1 and work 2 sc in every st on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (12)
- 3. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in first st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (18)
- 4. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 2 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (24)
- 5. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 3 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (30)
- 6. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 4 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (36)
- 7. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 5 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (42)
- 8. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 6 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (48)
- 9. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 7 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (54)
- 10. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 8 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (60)
- 11. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 9 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (66)
- 12. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 10 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (72)
- 13. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 11 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (78)
- 14. Ch 1 and work "1 sc in each of the first 12 st, 2 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" a total of 5 times. Work 1 sc in each of the last 13 st. Finish with 1 sl st. (83)
- 15. Ch 1 and work sc in BLO on entire round. Finish with 1 sl st. (83)
- 16. Now you proceed working in a spiral. Work "1 lsc in first st, 1 sc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 lsc.
- 17. Work "1 sc in first st, 1 lsc in next st". Repeat from "to" on entire round. Finish with 1 sc.


Repeat round 16 and 17 until you have worked a total of 8 rounds, working sc and lsc alternately. Finish with 1 round sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



Instruction- pattern:




1. This is how your finished bottom looks like.



2. Ch 1.



3. Now work 1 sc BLO. The needle shows in which loop to work your sc.



4. Like this.



5. Repeat on entire round and finish with 1 sl st.



6. Continue working in spiral. Begin by working a lsc. A lsc is a longs single crochet (or spike stitch), worked as a sc but around a stich from a previous row. The needle shows in which loop to work your lsc.





7. Like this. You have now worked 1 lsc.



8. Work 1 sc in next st.



9. Work 1 lsc. The needle shows in which loop to work your lsc.



10. Like this. You have now worked 1 lsc.



11. Work 1 sc in next st.



12. Repeat "1 lsc, 1 sc" on entire round. Finish with 1 lsc.






13. Work 1 sc in next st.



14. Work 1 lsc. The needle shows in which loop to work your lsc.




15. Like this.



16. Work 1 sc.



17. Work 1 lsc. The needle shows in which loop to work your lsc.



18. Like this.





19. Repeat "1 sc, 1 lsc" on entire round. Finish with 1 sc.



20. Repeat the rounds, working the sc and lsc alternately until you have worked at total of 8 rounds.



21. Finish with 1 round sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

<u>Instruction - straps:</u>

Cut 2 leather straps measuring 20 cm each. Punch holes through both ends of the straps and attach them on each side of the tray with the rivets. Use a small hammer to attach the rivets.









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
