



Maple Scarf

Materials

32" Circular Needles US 2 ½ (3 mm) Crochet Hook D 4 skeins of 50 g Soft Alpaca color 03 4 skeins of 50 g Soft Alpaca color 08

Size

One size

Finished Measurements

Width: 11 in (28 cm) Length: 70 in (180 cm)

Gauge

24 sts per 4" (10 cm) 27 rows per 4" (10 cm)

Pattern information

The scarf is knit flat on a circular needle. The stitches are slipped to the opposite end of the circular needle instead of turned so the 2-color pattern appears.



Two-colored pattern

Knit flat on a circular needle.

Starting Row: SI 1 st purlwise, *k1, YO, sI 1 purlwise * Repeat * to * until 1 st remains, k1.

The first st is an edge st and the last st is always knit.

The work is moved to the opposite needle tip, when starting the second color.

Knit alternating with 1 row of each color.

Knit alternating with 2 rows of knit (k2tog) and 2 rows of purl (p2tog).

Scarf

CO 66 sts with color A on the circular needle.

Change to color B and knit the starting row.

Continue in two-color pattern:

Row 1: Color A, 1 edge st, (YO, sl 1 purlwise, p2tog with yo and st) until there is 1 st remaining, k1.

Row 2: Color B, 1 edge st, (YO, sl 1 purlwise, p2tog with yo and st) until there is 1 st remaining, k1.

Row 3: Color A, 1 edge st, (k2tog with yo and st, YO, sl 1 purlwise) until there is 1 st remaining, k1.

Row 4: Color B, 1 edge st, (k2tog with yo and st, YO, sl 1 purlwise) until there is 1 st remaining, k1.

Repeat these 4 rows.

Continue evenly until the work measures approx. 70 in.

Bind off in rib.

Crochet 1 rnd of sc along all 4 edges, so there is a finished edge.
