



## Curly Baby Duckling

No. 1001-191-6563

### Materials:

- Crochet hooks 2.5 mm and 3.0mm
- Curly from Go Handmade
- Rainbow Cotton 8/4
- 2 safety eyes 10 mm
- 1 set of teether toys – animal feet
- Fiber Fill
- Rattle ball or other noise piece

### Abbreviations:

- ch:** chain
- st:** stitch
- sc:** single crochet
- tog:** together

**Finished Size:** Approx. 6" (15 cm) tall

### Yarn Requirements:

Approx. 35g Curly and a small amount of Rainbow 8/4

**Pattern:**

**Beak** – Made using Rainbow 8/4 and the smaller crochet hook (2.5mm)

Ch 6.

1. In the 2nd ch from the hook, work 1 sc. Work 1 sc in the next 3 sts. In the last st, work 3 sc. Now work into the back of the starting ch. Work 1 sc in the next 3 sts. Work 2 sc in the last st. (12)
2. Work 1 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work 1 sc in each st. (12)
4. Work 1 sc in the first 2 sts, work 2 sc in each of the next 2 sts. Work 1 sc in the last 8 sts. (14)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

**Head:** - Made using Curly and the larger crochet hook (3.0mm)

1. Starting with a magic ring, work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work \*1 sc, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work \*1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work \*1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. Work \*1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (36)
7. Work \*1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (42)
8. Work \*1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (48)
9. Work \*1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (54)
10. Work \*1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (60)
11. Work \*1 sc in the next 9 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (66)
12. -18. Work 1 sc in each st. (66)
19. Work \*1 sc in the next 9 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (60)
20. Work \*1 sc in the next 8 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (54)
21. Work \*1 sc in the next 7 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (48)
22. Work \*1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (42)
23. Work \*1 sc in the next 5 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (36)
24. Work \*1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (30)
25. Work \*1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (24)
26. Work \*1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (18)
27. Work 1 sc in each st. (18) Do not cut the yarn. Attach the eyes between rnds 14 & 5 with 12 sts between them. Fill with the cotton filling (fiber fill).

### Attaching the beak and eyes:



1. Place the eyes as instructed in the pattern.



2. Now attach the beak.



3. Sew the beak to the head between the eyes and a couple of rnds below.



4. Like this.



5. If you want to add depth under the eyes to give the duckling's face more shape, do the following: Using a darning needle, pull the yarn through the head



6. and out by the right side of the eye, as shown her. Insert the needle on the other side of the eye and through the head. Pull gently.



7. Repeat for the other eye. Pull the yarn through the head and out by the right side of the eye as shown here.



8. Insert the needle on the other side of the eye and through the head.



9. Pull gently on both ends of the yarn until you have the desired shape for both eyes. Tie a knot.



## Body:

Continue where you left off and work the body.

28. Work 2 sc in each st. (36)

29. Work 1 sc in each st (36)

30. Work \*1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (42)

31. Work \*1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (48)

32. Work \*1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (54)

33. – 36. Work 1 sc in each st (54)

34. Work \*1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (60)

35. – 39. Work 1 sc in each st. (60)

36. Work \*1 sc in the next 8 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (54)

40. Work \*1 sc in the next 7 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (48)
41. Work \*1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (42)
42. Work \*1 sc in the next 5 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (36)
43. Work \*1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (30)
44. Work \*1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (24) Fill the body before the hole becomes too small. If you want to add a rattle, do it now along with the fiber fill.
45. Work \*1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (18)
46. Work \*1 sc in the next st, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (12)
47. Work \*sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (6)

Sew the hole closed and weave in the ends.



### Attaching the feet:

With Curly and the larger crochet hook (3.0mm) work 2 straps for attaching the feet.

1. Ch 4. In the 2nd ch from the hook, work 1 sc. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
2. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
3. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
4. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
5. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
6. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)
7. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc in each st to the end of the row (3)



1. The feet are attached with these 2 straps.



2. Pull the short edge through the hole in the foot and fold as shown here.



3. Sew the edges together,



4. And sew it securely to the body.



5. Repeat for both feet.

## Wings:

Made using Curly and the larger crochet hook (3.0mm). Make 2.

1. Starting with a magic ring, work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work 1 sc in each st. (12)
4. Work \*1 sc, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* to the end of the rnd. (18)
5. Work 1 sc in each st. (18)
6. Work 1 sc in each st. (18)
7. Work \*1 sc, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* a total of 4 times. Work \*1 sc in the next st, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* a total of 3 times. Work 1 sc in the last st.
8. Work \*1 sc, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* a total of 4 times. Work \*1 sc in the next st, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* a total of 3 times. Work 1 sc in the last st.
9. Work \*1 sc, 2sc in the next st\* repeat \*-\* a total of 4 times. Work \*1 sc in the next st, sc2tog\* repeat \*-\* a total of 3 times. Work 1 sc in the last st.
10. Work 1 sc in each st.
11. Work 1 sc in each st.

Fold the wings flat and sc across the bottom to close.



1. The wings are now ready to be attached.



2. Sew them on either side of the body approx. 3 rnds below the start of the body.



3. Repeat on the other side.

### Tail Feathers:

1. Attach Curly in a st on the back side. Ch 6 and work 1 sc in the beginning st. Ch 8 and work 1 sc in the beginning st. Ch 6 and work 1 sc in the beginning st. Cut yarn and weave in the ends.
