



# **Knitted Wrap**

No. 2003-191-9299

## **Materials**

3 skeins of 3.5 oz. (100 g) of Woolpower, Happy Sheep, color 17

Circular needle 47.2 inches (120 cm), US size: 10.75 (7 mm)

Double pointed needle size 10 (6 mm) for i-cord edge

# Knitting gauge

16 stitches on 4" (10 cm) in rib, measured without pulling/stretching the item

# Sizes One size

#### Measurements

Circumference: approx. 33.5 inches (85 cm) Height: approx. 12.6 inches (32 cm)

## Pattern information

Cast on using the moebius technique which automatically creates the twisted effect. Then, you knit in the round in rib and the edge is finished with an i-cord.

## **Pattern**

Cast on 160 stitches with the moebius technique. Place a marker at the start of the round. From here, you knit in the round in rib \*knit 1, purl 1\* until the work measures 12.6 inches (32 cm) in height.

Do not cast off yet, instead you continue by knitting an i-cord edge over all the stitches.

## I-cord edge

Cast on 3 stitches with a knitted cast on on the left needle.

Knit with needle size 10 (6 mm): \*knit 2, knit 2 stitches together through the back loop (1 stitch from the right needle and 1 stitch from the left needle), place 3 stitches back on the left needle.\* Repeat from \*to\* until all stitches on the needle have been knitted. Sew the edges together by using kitchener stitch.
