



The Bears Felix & Fie

Materialer:

- Crochet hook 3.0mm
- Curly from Go Handmade
- Safety Eyes 12 mm
- Safety Nose 16mm
- Fiber Fill
- Bohème Velvet fine from Go Handmade for the scarf

Yarn Requirement per bear:

Curly: 60g (2 skeins)

Bohème Velvet fine: 5g

Abbreviations:

ch: chain

st: stitch

sc: single crochet

tog: together

dc: double crochet

Finished Size: Approx. 7 ½" (19 cm) tall

Pattern:

Head:

1. Starting with a magic ring, work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. Work 1 sc in each st. (30)
7. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (36)
8. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
9. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (42)
10. Work 1 sc in each st.. (42)
11. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (48)
12. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (54)
13. Work *1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (60)
14. Work *1 sc in the next 9 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (66)
15. -22. Work 1 sc in each st. (66)
23. Work *1 sc in the next 9 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (60)
24. Work 1 sc in each st. (60) Attach the nose between rnds 4 & 5 and the eyes between rnds 11 & 12 with 9-10 sts between them.
25. Work *1 sc in the next 8 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (54)
26. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (48)
27. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (42)
28. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (36)
29. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30)
30. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24) Place the fiber fill into the head at this point and continue to fill as you close the hole.
31. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
32. Work *1 sc in the next st, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (12)
33. Work *sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (6) Cut the yarn and sew the hole closed. Weave in the ends.



Shaping:



1. If you want to add depth under the eyes to give the duckling's face more shape, do the following: Using a darning needle, pull the yarn through the head,



2. and out by the right side of the eye, as shown here. Insert the needle on the other side of the eye and through the head. Pull gently.



3. Repeat for the other eye. Pull the yarn through the head and out by the right side of the eye as shown here.



4. Insert the needle on the other side of the eye and through the head.



5. Pull gently on both ends of the yarn until you have the desired shape for both eyes. Tie a knot.



Ears: - Make 2

1. Start with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring. (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. Work 1 sc in each st. (30)
7. Work 1 sc in each st. (30)

Fold the ear so it is flat and crochet closed using a row of sc. Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the ears to the head as shown below.



Body:

1. Start with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (36)
7. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (42)
8. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (48)
9. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (54)
10. Work *1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (60)
11. Work *1 sc in the next 9 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (66)
12. -17. Work 1 sc in each st. (66)
18. Work *1 sc in the next 9 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (60)
19. -21. Work 1 sc in each st. (60)
22. Work *1 sc in the next 8 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (54)
23. -24. Work 1 sc in each st. (54)

25. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (48)
26. -27. Work 1 sc in each st. (48)
28. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (42)
29. Work 1 sc in each st. (42)
30. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (36)
31. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30) Begin filling the body with fiber fill.
32. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24) Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew the body securely to the head.



Arms: - Make 2.

1. Start with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. -6. Work 1 sc in each st. (24)
7. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd (21)
8. Work 1 sc in each st. (21)
9. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd (18)
10. Work 1 sc in each st. (18)
11. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (15)
12. - 28. Work 1 sc in each st. (15)

Add fiber fill in the hand, and fold the arm flat. Close with a row of sc. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew securely to the body, just below the head.



Legs: - Make 2.

1. Start with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2sc in the next st* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. -7. Work 1 sc in each st. (30)
8. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (24)
9. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog* repeat *-* to the end of the rnd. (18)
10. -27. Work 1 sc in each st. (18)

Add fiber fill in the foot, and fold the leg flat. Close with a row of sc. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Attach the legs to the bottom of the body.



Scarf:

Work using Bohème Velvet fine

Note: Each row begins with a ch 2 to turn- this does not count as a st.

1. Ch 9. In the 3rd ch from the hook work 1 dc. Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.
2. Ch 2 and turn. Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row. (7)

Repeat row 2 a total of 37 times. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
