



KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

6 (7) 8 skeins of Portobello col. Red Cedar (18)

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 31.5 inches / 80 cm 6 buttons, 15 mm

YARN QUALITY

Portobello, Hobbii 60% cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

15 sts and 22 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch

SIZES

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width approx: 19.7 (21.7) 23.6 inches / 50 (55) 60 cm

Length approx: 18.9 (19.3) 19.7 inches / 48 (49) 50 cm

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The blouse is knitted down-up, back and forth on a circular needle.

You turn by using German Short Rows over the shoulders which are sewn together with the kitchener stitch. Lastly, you pick up and knit stitches in the armhole that is knitted with the magic loop technique.

INFO AND TIPS

Edge stitches

The first stitch on each round along the front piece is an edge stitch. You knit stitches for a rib edge along the edge stitches.

Body

Cast on 150 (165) 180 stitches on circular needle size 8 (5 mm), work back and forth. Work 6 rounds of rib *knit 1, purl 1*. Then you work stockinette stitch until your work measures 14.2 (14.2) 14.2 inches / 36 (36) 36 cm. Finish with a purl round. Place a marker, so you have 37 (41) 45 stitches to the front piece, 76 (83) 90 stitches to the back and 37 (41) 45 stitches to the front piece.

Right front piece

Work 1 round knitwise over the 37 (41) 45 stitches of the front piece.

Decrease the side of the neck, like this:

1.round: purl

2.round: knit 1, knit 2 stitches together knitwise, knit the rest of the round.

Repeat these two rounds until you have 24 (27) 30 stitches left to the shoulder.

Knit straight up until the armhole measures 7.5 (7.9) 8.3 inches / 19 (20) 21 cm. End with a purl round.

Cast off.

Back

Knit straight up in stockinette stitch until the armhole measures 6.3 (6.7) 7.1 inches / 16 (17) 18 cm. End with a purl round.

Place a marker on each side of the mid 16 (17) 18 stitches to the neck.

Shape shoulders and neck with German Short Rows/turning stitches:



Right shoulder

Knit 30 (33) 36 stitches, turn and knit a turning stitch, *knit until you have 8 stitches left at the shoulder, turn, knit 1 turning stitch, knit until you have 3 stitches left at the neck, turn, knit 1 turning stitch, knit until you have 16 stitches left at the shoulder, turn, knit 1 turning stitch, knit until you have 6 stitches left at the neck, turn, knit 1 turning stitch, knit the rest of the round by knitting the turning stitches together as 1 stitch, turn, cast off these 30 (33) 36 stitches by knitting the turning stitches together as 1 stitch.*

You should have 6 stitches to the neck and 24 (27) 30 stitches to the shoulder.

Neck

On the right side, cast off 16 (17) 18 stitches of the neck.

Left shoulder

Knit the left shoulder as you did with the right shoulder from *to*.

You should have 6 stitches to the neck and 24 (27) 30 stitches to the shoulder.

Left front piece

Knit the 37 (41) 45 stitches of the front piece knitwise.

Decrease the side of the neck, like this:

1.round: work knit stitches until you have 3 stitches left, knit 2 stitches together knitwise, knit 1. 2.round: purl.

Repeat these 2 rounds until you have 24 (27) 30 stitches left to the shoulder.

Knit straight up until the armhole measures 7.5 (7.9) 8.3 inches /19 (20) 21 cm.

End with a purl round.

Cast off.

Sew the 24 (27) 30 shoulder stitches together by using the kitchener stitch.

Sleeves

(knitted top-down)

Knit up approx. 48 (50) 52 stitches into the armhole on a circular needle. On the first round, knit the stitches through the back loop.

Knit straight up in stockinette stitch until your work measures 15.75 inches (40 cm), decrease with 10 stitches evenly divided on the round.

Knit 6 rounds of rib *knit 1, purl 1*.

Cast off in rib.

Knit the other sleeve in the same way.



Edges

Knit up stitches straight along the front edges and around the neck. Skip approx. every 3rd stitch.

Knit rib: *knit 1, purl 1* by knitting the stitches of the first round through the back loop.

On the 4th round, knit 6 button holes on the right front edge.

Divide the button holes from the bottom of the blouse to where the decreases on the front begins.

Button hole: work 2 stitches together knitwise, yarn over.

Knit back and forth in rib until you have knitted 8 rounds.

Cast off in rib.

Sew the buttons onto the left front edge.
