



# **Bohéme Sweater**

#### No. 2003-191-6868

### Materials

Circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm) size 10.75 (7 mm) Double pointed needle size 10.75 (7 mm)

Circular needle 31.5 inches (80 cm) size 8 (5 mm) (for i-cord)

13 (14) 15 skeins of 1.76 oz.(50 g) of Bohéme Velvet Double, color: Rusty

# Sizes

S (M) L

### Measurements

Width: 21.7 (23.6) 25.6 inches / 55 (60) 65 cm Length: 18.9 (19.7) 20.5 inches / 48 (50) 52 cm Knitting gauge (Double thread) 11 stitches on 4" / 10 cm 16 rows on 4" / 10 cm

#### Pattern information

The sweater is knitted down-up in double thread. You divide for armhole and thereafter the neck. Finally, you knit stitches up along the armhole from where you knit the sleeves.

You turn with German short rows, abbreviated: GSR

### Body

Cast on 120 (132) 142 s on circular needle size 10.75 (7 mm).

Knit in the round in stockinette stitch until your work measures 12.6 (13) 13.4 inches / 32 (33) 34 cm.

Place a marker in each side = side seams.

Set aside the stitches of the front, and finish the front and the back pieces one by one/individually = 60 (66) 71 stitches on each side.

# The back

Knit straight up in stockinette stitch until the armhole measures 6.7 (7) 7.5 inches / 17 (18) 19 cm.

Cast off every single stitch.

# The front

Knit the front piece straight up in stockinette stitch until the armhole measures 4 inches / 10 cm.

Finish with a purl row.

Knit 23 (25) 27 stitches knitwise, cast off 14 (16) 17 stitches for the neckline, knit 23 (25) 27 stitches knitwise.

Knit the right and the left side of the front piece individually.

#### Right front (when wearing the blouse)

Cast off 1 stitch in the neck side on each row 4 times = 19(21)23 stitches to the shoulder. Knit straight up until the work measures 7.5 (7.9) 8.3 inches/ 19 (20) 21 cm. Finish with a purl row.

Knit German short rows over the shoulders to obtain a better fit. Do not cast off the stitches, but knit short rows:

#### Short rows

- Knit until you have 8 stitches left at the shoulder, turn with GSR
- Knit until you have 3 stitches left at the neck, turn with GSR
- Knit until you have 10 stitches left at the shoulder, turn with GSR
- Knit until you have 4 stitches left at the neck, turn with GSR
- Knit until you have 12 stitches left at the shoulder, turn with GSR
- Knit until you have 5 stitches left at the neck, turn with GSR

Knit the rest of the row and cast off the stitches.

#### Left front (when wearing the blouse)

Cast off 1 stitch in the neckline on each row 4 times = 19(21) 23 stitches to the shoulder. Knit straight up until your work measures 7.5 (7.9) 8.3 inches / 19(20) 21 cm. Finish with 1 row of knit stitches.



Do not cast off the stitches, but knit short rows just like you did with the first shoulder.

Sew the shoulders together.

#### Sleeves, knitted top-down.

Knit approx. 42 (43) 44 stitches up along the armhole. In the first round, you knit the stitches through the back loop.

Knit straight up in stockinette stitch until your work measures 16.14 (16.5) 16.9 inches / 41 (42) 43 cm.

Knit i-cord edges along the wrist.

Knit the other sleeve in the same way.

Weave in ends.

#### I-cord

Knit stitches up along the neckline, Cast on 3 stitches with\_knitted cast on (so they are placed on the left knitting needle). Knit i-cord: \*knit 2, knit 2 stitches together through the back loops\*, repeat \* - \* till the end of the round.

Knit i-cord edges along the bottom of the blouse in the exact same way.
