

## Granny Twister Cardigan

## Materials:

- Hobbii Twister
- Hobbii Twister Solid
- Crochet Hook US 7 (4.5mm)


## Buy the yarn and materials here:

Size: One size
Measurement: The square measures approx. 40" x $40 "(102 \times 102 \mathrm{~cm})$ Before sewing.

## Yarn Requirement approx.:

Twister: 250g (1 skein)
Twister Solid: 110g (2 skeins)

## Abbreviations:

ch: chain
st: stitch
sc: single crochet
hdc: half double crochet
dc: double crochet
sl st: slip stitch

Pattern - Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

1. Begin with a magic ring. Ch 3 , work 2 dc into the ring and ch 2 . Work *3dc, ch 2 * Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
2. Sl st to the ch-space. Ch 3 , ( 2 dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same ch-space. Work * $(3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1)$ in the next ch-space* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
3. Sl st to the ch-space corner. Ch 3, (2dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next ch- space. Work * 3 dc , ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the next ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next ch-space.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
4. Sl st to the ch-space corner. Ch 3, (2dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 2 ch- spaces. Work *( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) in the next ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 2 ch-spaces.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
5. Sl st to the ch-space corner. Ch 3, (2dc, ch 2, $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) in the same ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 3 ch- spaces. Work *( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) in the next ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 3 ch-spaces.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
6. Sl st to the ch-space corner. Ch 3 , ( 2 dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 4 ch- spaces. Work *(3dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 4 ch-spaces.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.
7. Sl st to the ch-space corner. Ch 3 , ( 2 dc , ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 5 ch- spaces. Work *(3dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1) in the next ch-space corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next 5 ch-spaces.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. End with a sl st.

Continue in this manner until you have a total of 50 rnds on your square. Crochet with Twister until there is no more left. Continue with Twister Solid.

## Finishing Rnd:

Ch 3 , work 1 dc in the next 2 sts. *In the ch-space corner work 6 dc . Work dc in each st and ch-space along the edge until you reach the next corner.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. In the last ch-space corner work 6 dc . Work dc in each st and ch-space along the last edge to the starting ch. End with a sl st.

There will be 199 dc on each edge plus 6 dc in each ch-space corner (820). Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

## Assembly:

Fold the square in the middle. Sew the end pieces together until there are approx. 98 sts remaining for the arm holes.


## Sleeves:

1. Attach the yarn and ch 1 . Work sc in each st around the opening and end with a sl st.
2. Ch 2 and work hdc in each st around. End with a sl st.
3. Ch 1 and work sc in each st around. End with a sl st.
4. Ch 2 and work hdc in each st around. End with a sl st.
5. Ch 1 and work sc in each st around. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.


## Edge for the body:

1. Attach the yarn and ch 1 . Work sc in each st around the opening and end with a sl st.
2. Ch 2 and work hdc in each st around. End with a sl st.
3. Ch 1 and work sc in each st around. End with a sl st..
4. Ch 2 and work hdc in each st around. End with a sl st.
5. Ch 1 and work sc in each st around. End with a sl st.
6. Ch 2 and work hdc in each st around. End with a sl st.
7. Ch 1 and work sc in each st around. End with a sl st. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.


## Photo Tutorial for the granny square:

## Rnd 1



1. Begin with a magic ring. Ch 3 ,

2. and ch 2 .

3. Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.
4. work 2 dc into the ring,

5. Work *3dc, ch $2^{*}$

6. End with a sl st.

## Rnd 2



1. Sl st to the ch-space.
2. Ch $3,(2 d c$, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1$)$ in the same chspace.
3. Like this.



4. Like this.

5. Work *(3dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the next chspace*.

6. Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.

7. End with a sl st.

## Rnd 3



1. Sl st to the ch-space corner.

2. Ch 3 , (2dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the same chspace corner.

3. Like this.

4. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next ch- space.

5. Like this.

6. Repeat * to * a total of 3 times.

## Rnd 4 to the end

1. Continue in this manner as instructed in the written pattern.


2. Work *(3dc, ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 ) in the next chspace corner. Work 3 dc and ch 1 in the next ch-space.*.
3. End with a sl st.


Finishing Rnd


1. Ch 3 , work 1 dc in the next 2 sts. *In the chspace corner work 6 dc . Work dc in each st and ch-space along the edge until you reach the next corner.* Repeat * to * a total of 3 times. In the last ch-space corner work 6 dc . Work dc in each st and ch-space along the last edge to the starting ch. End with a sl st.


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
