Materials:

- Crochet Hook B/C (2.5mm)
- Rainbow 8/4 Stonewash
- Fiber Fill
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations:

- st:** stitch
sc: single crochet
BL: Back loop

Finished Size:

Height: 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. (12 cm) including the ears
Width: 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. (3.9 cm) at the widest point
 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. (2 cm) at the smallest point

Pattern:

Head and Body: With Stonewash (color 16)

1. Begin with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring. (6)
2. Work 2 sc in each st. (12)
3. Work *1 sc, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (18)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (24)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (30)
6. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (36)
7. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
8. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
9. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
10. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
11. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
12. Work 1 sc in each st. (36)
13. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (30)
14. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (24)
15. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (18)
16. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
17. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
18. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
19. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd (21)
20. Work 1 sc in each st (21)
21. Work 1 sc in each st (21)
22. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd (24)
23. Work 1 sc in each st (24)
24. Work 1 sc in each st (24)
25. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd (27)
26. Work 1 sc in each st (27)
27. Work 1 sc in each st (27)
28. Work *1 sc in the next 8 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the (30)
29. Work 1 sc in each st (30)
30. Work 1 sc in each st (30)
31. Work 1 sc in each st (30)
32. Work 1 sc in each st (30)
33. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. ((24)
34. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd (18)
35. Work *1 sc in the next st, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd (12)
36. sc2tog to the end of the rnd (6)

Ears: With Stonewash (color 16) (make 2)

1. Begin with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring. (6)
2. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (8)
3. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (10)
4. Work *1 sc in the next 4 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (12)
5. Work *1 sc in the next 5 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (14)
6. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (16)
7. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, 2 sc in the next st* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (18)
8. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
9. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
10. Work 1 sc in each st (18)
11. Work *1 sc in the next 7 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (16)
12. Work *1 sc in the next 6 sts, sc2tog* Repeat *to* to the end of the rnd. (14)
13. Work 1 sc in each st (14)

Tie off and leave a long tail for sewing the ear to the head.

Eyes: Start with black (make 2)

1. Begin with a magic ring and work 6 sc into the ring – end with a sl st in the first sc (6)
2. (Change to the white – **work in the BL**) Work 2 sc in the same st as the sl st, (2 sc), (1 hdc+1dc), (1dc + 1 hdc), (2 sc), (2sc), 1 sc in the black sl st – end with a sl st in the first sc. (13)

Tie off and leave a long tail for sewing the eyes to the head.

Assembly:

Ears:

Sew the ears together at the bottom and sew the right corner of the bottom to the left. Then sew the ears to the head over rnds 3 & 4 one either side of the middle.



Eyes and nose:

Attach the eyes over rnds 6-10 with 2 sts in between.
Embroider the nose with pink yarn between rows 9 and 10.
It is also an option to embroider the eyes for a different look.
