



# Helle Sweater

## Materials

7 (8) 9 (10) skeins of 50 g Soft Alpaca,  
color 24

Crochet Hook G- 4 mm

Stitch markers

## Sizes

S (M) L (XL)

## Finished Measurements

Width: 17  $\frac{3}{4}$  (19  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) 21  $\frac{1}{2}$  (23  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) in./ 45 (50)  
55 (60) cm

Length: 23  $\frac{1}{2}$  (22) 22  $\frac{1}{2}$  (22  $\frac{3}{4}$ ) in. / 55 (56)  
57 (58) cm

## Gauge

19 dc per 4" / 10 cm  
13 rows per 4" / 10 cm

## Pattern Information

The sweater is crocheted in double crochet (dc)  
with raglan-decreases.

The sweater has a V-neck and  $\frac{3}{4}$  length  
sleeves.

### Back

Ch 86 (96) 106 (116) loosely and turn with 2 ch sts = 86 (96) 106 (116) sts. Turn each row with a ch 2.

Continue in dc until the piece measures 13  $\frac{3}{4}$  in/ 35 cm. End with a WS row.

Tie off the end. Set the piece aside while you work the front piece.

### Front

Work in the same way as the back. End with a WS row.

Set the piece aside while you work the sleeves

### Sleeves

Ch 40 (42) 44 (46) loosely and turn with 2 ch sts = 40 (42) 44 (46) sts. Turn each row with a ch 2.

Continue in dc, while increasing on both sides on every 3rd row until there are 58 (64) 72 (78) sts.

Crochet evenly until the piece measures 13  $\frac{1}{4}$  in./ 34 cm =  $\frac{3}{4}$  length sleeves. End with a WS row.

Work a second sleeve to match.

### Yoke

Join the pieces together. Begin at the middle point of the Front piece = 43 (48) 53 (58) sts either side.

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 dc, dc2tog, dc across until there are 5 (5) 6 (6) sts remaining on the front, skip 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on the first sleeve.

Crochet across the sleeve until there are 5 (5) 6 (6) sts remaining, skip 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on the back piece.

Crochet across the back piece until there are 5 (5) 6 (6) sts remaining, skip 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on the 2nd sleeve.

Crochet across the 2nd sleeve until there are 5 (5) 6 (6) sts remaining, skip 5 (5) 6 (6) sts on the front piece.

Crochet across until there are 3 sts remaining on the front piece, dc2tog, dc = 246 (278) 306 (338) sts.

**Row 2 (WS):** dc in each st.

Place a marker at each seam = 4 raglan seams. Turn each row with a ch 2.

### Continue with decreases to for the v-neck and raglan shaping:

1 dc, dc2tog \*crochet to 3 sts before the marker, dc2tog, 2 dc, dc2tog \*, repeat \*-\* 4 times total. Crochet to 3 sts remaining, dc2tog, dc = 8 sts decreased for the raglan shaping and 2 sts decreased for the neck shaping.

Repeat this row until there are no more sts remaining on the front piece.

### Assembly

Sew the sleeves and side seams together.

Sew the gap under the arm together.
