Materials

2 (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) skeins of 100 g Twister, solid color 110
1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of 250 g Cotton Kings Color Bomb, color 501
32" (80cm) Circular needle US 4 (3.5mm) and US 8 (5 mm)
Stitch markers

Finished Measurements

Width:

16 (17 ½) 19 ½ (20 ½) 22 ½ (23 ½) in. 41 (44) 49 (52) 57 (60) cm Width, bottom edge: 21 ½ (22 ½)24 ½ (26) 28 (29) in. 54 (57) 62 (66) 71 (74) cm Length: 22 ½ (22 ¾) 23 ¼ (23 ½) 24 (24 ½) in. 57 (58) 59 (60) 61 (62) cm

Gauge

In pattern 22 sts / 28 rounds = 4" (10 cm)

Sizes

XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL)

Pattern information

The sweater is knit from the top down in stockinette with pattern.

The yoke is worked in the round using the magic loop technique.

Stitches are bound off for the sleeves and continue working for the rest of the body which forms an A-line shape.

Knit 2 rnds with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm) with 1 strand. Then knit 2 rnds with Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm). Repeat these 4 rounds.

Pattern

Yoke

CO 96 sts with Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm). Knit 1 rnd with both yarns.

Begin Increases

Place a marker after every 6 sts = 16 markers.

Rnd 1: Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm)

Rnd 2: Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm) while increasing as follows:

**k to marker, M1 **, Repeat ** to ** to the end of the rnd = 16 sts increased.

Rnd 3 and 4: Knit with Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm).

Repeat these 4 rnds.

Continue until there are 320 (336) 352 (368) 400 (416) sts. End with Rnd 1(only Twister). Knit 1 rnd with Twister increasing 0 (0) 8 (8) 0 (0) sts = 320 (336) 360 (376) 400 (416) sts. Knit 2 rnds with Twister and Color Bomb on the larger needle US 8 (5mm).

Place a marker to indicate the beginning of the rnd. Place marker after *72 (72) 74 (74) 76 (76) sts for the sleeve, place a marker after 88 (96) 106 (114) 124 (132) sts for the front, repeat from * for the 2nd sleeve and back piece.

Body

Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm).

Rnd 1: Bind off sleeve sts, knit sts for the front piece, bind off sleeve sts, knit sts for the back piece = 176 (192) 212 (228) 248 (264) sts.

Rnd 2: Increase evenly by 4 (0) 4 (0) 4 (0) sts = 180 (192) 216 (228) 252 (264) sts.

Knit 2 rnds with Twister and Color Bomb on the larger needle US 8 (5mm).

Begin Increasing

Place a marker to indicate the beginning of the rnd, place a marker after 30 (32) 36 (38) 42 (44) sts = 6 markers.

Rnd 1: Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm).

Rnd 2: Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm) while increasing as follows:

k to marker, M1 Repeat * to * to the end of the rnd = 6 sts increased.

Rnds 3 and 4: Knit with Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm).

Rnds 5 and 6: Knit with Twister on the smaller needle US 4 (3.5mm).

Rnds 7 and 8: Knit with Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm).



Repeat these 8 rnds.

Increase a total of 10 times = 60 sts = 240 (252) 276 (288) 312 (324) sts total.

Continue knitting evenly until the piece measures approx. 13 $\frac{1}{4}$ (13 $\frac{1}{4}$) 13 (12 $\frac{1}{2}$) 12 (12) in. / 34 (34) 33 (32) 31 (31) cm from the armhole.

End with 2 rnds of Twister and Color Bomb held together on the larger needle US 8 (5mm). Bind off loosely.
