Cat Rattle No. 1009-192-8110

Level: Intermediate Crochet hook: size B/1-C/2 (2.5 mm) Materials: Embroidery needle, 2 safety eyes size 0.3 inches (8 mm) 1 rattle, fiber fill. Yarn: Hobbii Rainbow 8/4: Baby Blue (32), White (1), Light peach (48). How much yarn should I use? Baby Blue: 1 skein White: 1 skein Light peach: 1 skein

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet
[...] = number of stitches
(...) = number of rounds
MR = magic ring
inc = 2 sc in the same stitch
dec = work 2 sc together

Head in blue

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: inc 6 times [12]

Rnd 3: *1 sc, inc* 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: *2 sc, inc* 6 times [24]

Rnd 5: *3 sc, inc* 6 times [30]

Rnd 6:* 4 sc, inc* 6 times [36]

Rnd 7: *5 sc, inc* 6 times [42]

Rnd 8 –14: 1 sc in each stitch (7 rnds) [42] Place the safety eyes between rnd 10/11 with an interspace of 7 stitches between the two eyes.

Rnd 15: *5 sc, dec* 6 times [36]

Rnd 16: *4 sc, dec* 6 times [30]

Rnd 17: *3 sc, dec* 6 times [24]

Rnd 18: *2 sc, dec* 6 times [18] Now, you insert the rattle in the head and stuff the head with fiber fill.

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Handle

Rnd 19–21 White 1 sc in each stitch (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 22–24: Blue 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 25–27: White 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 28-30: Blue 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 31-33: White 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 34-36: Blue 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 37-39: White 1 sc in each s (3 rnds) [18]

Rnd 40: Blue 1 sc in each s [18]

Rnd 41: *1 sc, dec* 6 times [12]

Rnd 42: *dec* 6 times [6]

Stuff the handle firmly; especially at the transition from the head to the handle. Cut the yarn, but leave a long tail so you are able to insert the thread through the front loops of the 6 sc stitches in rnd 42. Tighten and weave in the end.

Ears 2x in blue

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: *2 sc, inc* 2 times [8]

Rnd 3: *3 sc, inc* 2 times [10]

Rnd 4-5: 1 sc in each stitch (2 rnds) [10] Cut the yarn and leave a long tail for sewing. Sew the ears onto the head from rnd 2-7. Please see the picture.





Snout in white

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a MR [6]

Rnd 2: *inc* 6 times [12]

Rnd 3: *3 sc, inc* 3 times [15]

Rnd 4-5: 1 sc in each s (2 rnds) [15]

Cut the yarn and sew the snout onto the head between the eyes. The snout should be placed between rnd 9/10 and rnd 14/15. Stuff the snout while you attach it to the head. Embroider a peach-colored nose onto the snout. Please see the picture below.

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
