



Peru Cushion

Materials

10 skeins of 50 g Highland Wool in mixed colors

32" (80 cm) Circular needle, US 4 (3.5 mm)

Pillow insert 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" (42 x 42 cm)

Finished Size

Width: 15 ¾" (40 cm) Length: 31 ½" (80 cm)

Fits on a pillow form size 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (42x42 cm.)

Gauge

1 repeat of 16sts = $2\frac{1}{4}$ " (6 cm)

Zig-Zag-pattern (repeat of 16 + 1 sts)

Pattern information

The pillow is knit flat in stockinette on a circular needle.

The pillow is sewn together with kitchener stitch on the top and bottom edges and with mattress stitch along the sides.

K3tog: slip 2 sts as if to know, k1, pass the slipped sts over.

M1: pick up the bar between the last stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from the back to the front. Then knit into the front of this stitch.



Pillow cover

CO 115 sts and work 1 row of purl sts.

Continue in pattern and stripes as follows:

Row 1 pattern row (RS): k f&b, k7, k3tog, k6, M1, k1, M1 *k6, k3tog, k6, M1, k1, M1* repeat *-* until there are 17 sts remaining. k6, k3tog, k6, kf&b, k1 = 115 sts

Row 2 pattern: p all sts.

Repeat these 2 pattern rows until the piece measures 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (80 cm). Change colors along the way working between 2 – 6 rows in each color. Always work an even number of rows so the yarn will be on the right edge of the work.

Bind off, wrap around the pillow form and sew the edges together using kitchener stitch for the top and bottom seams and mattress stitch along the side.
