



Argentina Cushion

Materials

3 skeins of 50 g Highland Wool

32" (80 cm) Circular needle US 4 (3.5 mm)

Pillow 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" (42 x 42 cm)

Finished Size

Width: 15 ¾" (40 cm) Length: 31 ½" (80 cm)

Fits a pillow size 16 ½" x 16 ½" (42 x 42 cm)

Gauge

1 repeat of 16 sts = $2\frac{1}{4}$ " (6 cm)

Zig-Zag-pattern (repeats of 16 + 1 sts)

Pattern information

The pillow is knit flat in stockinette on a circular needle.

The pillow is sewn together with kitchener stitch on the top and bottom edges and with matteress stitch along the sides.

k3tog: slip 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass the slipped sts over.

M1: use the left needle to pick up the bar between the stitches from front to back. Use the right needle to knit this bar through the back loop.



Cushion Cover

CO 115 sts and p one row.

Continue in pattern and stripe as follows:

Row 1 pattern (RS): k f&b, k 7, k3tog, k 6, M1, k1, M1 *k6, k3tog, k6, M1, k1, M1* Repeat * to * until there are 17 sts remaining k6, k3tog, k6, kf&b, k1 = 115 sts.

Row 2 pattern (WS): p all sts.

Repeat these 2 rows until the piece measures approx. 31 ½" (80 cm).

Bind off, put the cushion in the cover and sew the cover together using kitchener stitch for the top and bottom and mattress stitch for the sides.
