



Lau Tie

No. 2003-192-3371

Materials:

1 skein of 50 g Highland Wool color 34

32" circular needle US 4 (3.5mm)

Gauge:

23 sts per 4"/ 10 cm

34 rows per 4"/ 10 cm

Finished Measurements

Widest point: 3"/ 7.5 cm

Increasing

The increases are made with a YO. On the next rnd work this YO through the back loop to twist.

The tie is knit using the magic loop technique.

Pattern

CO 6 sts. Divide them on the cable so that you are knitting 3 sts at a time. Keep the sts divided in this manner so they become the front and back of the tie.

Increasing

Increases are worked on the odd rows.

Rnd 1: *k1, YO, k1, YO, k1 * - repeat for the back side.

Rnd 2: k all sts working the YOs through the back loop to twist.

Rnd 3: *k1, YO, k3, YO, k1 * - repeat for the back side.

Rnd 4: k all sts working the YOs through the back loop to twist.

Rnd 5: *k1, YO, k5, YO, k1 * - repeat for the back side.

Rnd 6: k all sts working the YOs through the back loop to twist.

Continue increasing in this manner until there are 23 sts on both sides = 46 sts total.

Decreasing

Rnd 1: *k1, k2tog, k17, ssk, k1* - repeat for the back side.

Rnd 2: k all sts.

Rnd 3: k all sts.

Rnd 4: k1, *k2tog, k15, ssk, k1* - repeat for the back side.

Rnd 5: k all sts.

Rnd 6: k all sts.

Rnd 7: *k1, k2tog, k13, ssk, k1* - repeat for the back side.

There are now 34 sts per row.

Continue decreasing every 2"/ 5 cm, for a total of 6 times = 22 sts.

Knit in the round in stockinette until the piece measures approx. 55"/ 140 cm, or until you reach your desired length.

Decrease again on either side on each row until there are 6 sts remaining.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
