



Orla Hat

No. 2003-192-5448

Materials

2 skeins of Soft Alpaca- 50 g
DPN or 32" Circular needle US 2 ½ (3 mm)

Sizes

S (M) L

Finished Measurements

Circumference:
17 ¾ (19 ¾) 21 ¼ in./ 46 (50) 54 cm

Stretches in width

Gauge

28 sts per 4" / 10 cm

Pattern information

The hat is knit from the bottom up. It is worked in stockinette in the round on either Double Pointed Needles (DPNs) or circular needles using the Magic Loop. There is no rib edge, so the cast on edge will create a rolled edge.

Hat

CO 130 (140) 150 sts and work in stockinette in the round (knit all sts) until the piece measures 9"/ 23 cm.

Begin decreases

Rnd 1: Work *k3, k2tog *, repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Rnd 2: k all sts.

Rnd 3: Work *k2, k2tog *, repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Rnd 4: k all sts.

Rnd 5: Work *k1, k2tog *, repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Rnd 6: k all sts.

Rnd 7: Work *k2tog *, repeat *-* to the end of the rnd.

Cut the yarn. Pull the end through the remaining sts and pull tightly to close the hole. Weave in the ends on the WS.

Wash the hat and let it dry while blocking. Press the edge a bit so the it doesn't roll too much.
