



## Kitchen Towel - Daisy

### Materials:

- Rainbow 8/4 – Color 75
- Crochet Hook C/D 3.0mm

### Abbreviations:

- ch:** chain  
**st:** stitch  
**sc:** single crochet  
**dc:** double crochet

**Finished Size:** Approx. 16 ½ x 12 ½” or 42x32 cm

**Yarn Requirements:** Approx. 90g (2 skeins)

**Pattern - Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern**

1. Ch 78. In the 4th ch from the hook, work 1 dc. Work dc in each ch st to the end of the row.
2. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.
3. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.
4. Ch 1 and turn (counts as 1 sc) Work 2 dc in the first st. "Skip 2 sts and work (1 sc, 2 dc) in the next st". Repeat "to" to the end of the row. End with 1 sc in the last st.
5. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.
6. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.

**Repeat rows 4-6 at total of 15 times.**

48. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.
49. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the next 35 sts. Ch 4, skip 4 sts and work 1 dc in the last 36 sts.
50. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row. In the ch-space work 4 dc.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



## **Pattern Tutorial:**

The guide is made using less sts but the pattern is the same.

### **Row 1**



1. Ch 78.



2. In the 4th ch from the hook, work 1 dc.



3. Like this.



4. Work dc in each ch st to the end of the row.

### **Row 2**



1. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc).



2. Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.

### Row 3



1. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.

### Row 4



1. Ch 1 and turn (counts as 1 sc).



2. Work 2 dc in the first st.



3. Like this.



4. Skip 2 sts.



5. work (1 sc, 2 dc) in the next st.



6. Skip 2 sts.



7. work (1 sc, 2 dc) in the next st.



8. Repeat to the end of the row.



9. Work 1 sc in the top of the turning ch 3 from the previous row.

### Row 5



1. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc).



2. Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.



3. The last dc is worked in the turning ch from the previous row.

### Row 6



1. Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc).



2. Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.

### Rows 7 to 47



Repeat rows 4-6 a total of 15 times.

### Rows 48-50



Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row.

Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in the next 35 sts. Ch 4, skip 4 sts and work 1 dc in the last 36 sts.

Ch 3 and turn (counts as 1 dc). Work 1 dc in each st to the end of the row. In the ch-space, work 4 dc.



Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
