



# **Chestnut Scarf**

No. 2003-192-7341

#### **Materials**

1 skein of 250 g Sultan Deluxe color 02

47" (120 cm) Circular needle US 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  (3 mm) DPNs US 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  (3 mm) for the i cord edge

#### Gauge

28 sts per 4"/ 10 cm 34 rows per 4"/ 10 cm

#### Size One size

Finished Measurement Circumference: approx. 40"/ 100 cm Height: approx. 18"/ 45 cm

#### **Difficulty Level**

Experienced, due to the cast on technique, otherwise it is easy

#### Pattern information

It begins with a mobius cast on technique which automatically creates the twist effect. Then it is worked in the rnd in stockinette and is finished with an i-cord.

## Pattern

CO 280 sts with a mobius cast on technique. Place a marker to indicate the beginning of the rnd.

Now knit in the round in stockinette until the piece measures approx. 18" /45 cm in height. NOTE Always work knit sts, because of the mobius twist one side will show the knit side and the other half will show the purl side.

Do not bind off, but continue by working an i-cord edge across all sts.

#### I-cord edge

CO 3 sts with a knitted cast on on the left needle.

Using the US 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  (3mm) needle work: \*k2,k2tog with 1 st from the right needle and 1 st from the left needle), place the 3 sts back onto the left needle \*. Repeat \* to \* until all the sts have been worked. Sew the i-cord together.
