



Kitchen Towel – Sweet Waves

No. 1001-192-8552

Materials:

- Rainbow 8/4 – Color 82
- Crochet Hook C/D 3.0mm
- Leather string for hanging loop

Abbreviations:

ch: chain
st: stitch
dc: double crochet
tog: Together (decrease)

Finished Size:

approx. 15 ¾" x 11 ¾" / 40x30 cm

If you would like it to be larger, start with a ch that is a multiple of 14.

Yarn Requirements: Approx. 80g (2 skeins)

Pattern - Photo tutorial can be found following the written pattern

Note. Each row is started with ch 3 and turn that is counted as 1 dc.

1. Ch 72. In the 3rd ch from the hook, work 2 dc. (Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. "work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" twice. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. Work 3 in each of the next 2 sts) Repeat (to) across the row until there are 4 sts remaining. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts and 3 dc in the last st.
2. Ch 3 and turn. Work 2 dc in the first st. (Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. "work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" twice. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. Work 3 in each of the next 2 sts) Repeat (to) across the row until there are 4 sts remaining. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts and 3 dc in the last st.

Repeat row 2 until you have a total of 38 rows.
Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.

Attach a piece of leather string for hanging the towel.



Pattern Tutorial:

This guide is made with fewer sts but the method is the same.

Row 1



1. Ch 72.



2. In the 3rd ch from the hook, work 2 dc.



3. Like this.



4. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



5. Work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts. (This means that you should decrease the 3 sts to 1)



6. Repeat and work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts.



7. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



8. Work 3 dc in the next st.



9. Repeat and work 3 dc in the next st.



10. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. "work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" twice.



11. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. Work 3 in each of the next 2 sts.



12. Continue in this manner until there are 4 sts remaining.



13. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



14. In the last st, work 3 dc.

Row 2



1. Ch 3 and turn.



2. Work 2 dc in the first st.



3. Like this.



4. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



5. Work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts.



6. Repeat and work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts.



7. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



8. Work 3 dc in the next st.



9. Repeat and work 3 dc in the next st.



10. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. "work 3 dc tog over the next 3 sts". Repeat "to" twice.



11. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts. Work 3 in each of the next 2 sts.



12. Continue until there are 4 sts remaining.



13. Work 1 dc in the next 3 sts.



14. In the last st, work 3 dc.



15. Like this.



Rows 3 - 38



1. Repeat row 2 until you have a total of 38 rows.

Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.



2. Attach a leather string for hanging the towel.
