## Materials

32" Circular needle US 6 ( 4 mm ) Crochet hook C/D 3.0 mm 5 skeins of 50 g Highland color 37

## Size

One size

## Finished Measurements

Width approx: 51"/ 130 cm
Height approx: $251 / 2 \prime$ / 65 cm

## Gauge

22 sts per $4 " / 10 \mathrm{~cm}$.
1 domino $=53 / 4$ " $\times 53 / 4$ " $/ 14.5 \times 14.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ diagonal

## Abbreviations

st: stitch
tbl: through the back loop (twisted) tog: together (decrease)
sl 1: slip 1 stitch as if to knit, insert right needle into the stitch from the left to right with the yarn held behind the work.
k2tog: knit 2 stitches together.
k2tog tbl: knit 2 stitches together, but through the back loop to twist the stitches.
SK2P: (double decrease) slip 1 st as if to knit,
k2tog, pass the slipped stitch over the stitch that's
left after knitting the two stitches together.
sc: single crochet
ch: chain stitch

## First row

## First domino

CO 47 sts.
Row 1 (WS): sl $1, k$ to the end of the row.
Place a marker around the center stitch.
Row 2 (RS): sl $1, k$ to 1 st before the marker, SK2P, $k$ to the end of the row.
Repeat these 2 rows until there are 3 sts remaining.
Next row (RS): sl 1, k2tog, psso = 1 st remaining.

## Second domino

Pick up 23 sts along the domino's left side $(R S)=24$ sts, CO 23 sts with a knitted cast on = 47 sts.
Place a marker around the center stitch.
Row 1 (WS): knit to the end of the row.
Row 2 (RS): sl $1, k$ to 1 st before the marker, SK2P, $k$ to the end of the row.
Row 3 (WS): sl $1, k$ to the end of the row.
Continue knitting the domino in the same manner as the first domino.
Third domino
Work in the same manner as the second domino.
Continue until there are 8 dominoes total.

## Half domino

Pick up 23 sts along the domino's left side (RS) = 24 sts, CO 23 sts with a knitted cast on = 47 sts.
Row 1 (WS): knit to the end of the row.
Row 2 (RS): sl 1, k2tog tbl, $k$ to 1 st before the marker, SK2P, $k$ across until there are 3 sts remaining, k2tog, k1.
Row 3 (WS): sl 1, $k$ to the end of the row.
Continue decreasing on either end and in the middle until there are 7 sts remaining.
Bind off loosely from the WS row. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends

## Second row

## First domino

CO 24 sts, pick up 23 sts from the RS along the left side of the first domino in the first row = 47 m.
Row 1 (WS): sl $1, k$ to the end of the row.
Place a marker around the center stitch.
Row 2 (RS): sl 1, $k$ to 1 st before the marker, SK2P, $k$ to the end of the row.
Continue knitting in the same manner as the first domino.

## Second domino

Pick up 23 sts along the domino's left side, pick up 23 sts from the RS along the left side of the second domino in the first row $=47 \mathrm{~m}$.
Row 1 (WS): knit to the end of the row.
Place a marker around the center stitch.
Row 2 (RS): sl 1, $k$ to 1 st before the marker, SK2P, $k$ to the end of the row.
Row 3 (WS): sl $1, k$ to the end of the row.
Continue knitting in the same manner as the first domino.

Continue until there are 7 dominoes in the 2 nd row.
Knit 1 half domino as before. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
Continue with the $3^{\text {rd }}$ row with 6 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue with the $4^{\text {th }}$ row with 5 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue with the $5^{\text {th }}$ row with 4 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue with the $6^{\text {th }}$ row with 3 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue with the $7^{\text {th }}$ row with 2 whole and 1 half domino.
Continue with the $8^{\text {th }}$ row with 1 whole and 1 half domino.
Weave in all ends.

## Edge

Rnd 1: crochet 1 rnd of sc along all edges.
Rnd 2: (work 3 sc , skip $1 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) to the end of the rnd


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
